## Match challenge

**TO ENCOURAGE** young British match-racers, the Royal Lyminster Yacht Club is organising a match-racing competition on the weekend of May 10/11 for the Westerly Crebbin Cup.

Six invited helmsmen and women, probably all under the age of 25, will sail matches against each other, and the winner will be invited to try his hand against the world's best (perhaps even against the winner of the 1987 America's Cup?) in the Westerly Royal Lyminster Lap the following week.

Spectators are welcome at both events, which will be held in Christchurch Bay or the Solent, depending on the weather.

Those without access to a boat should apply for a space aboard one of the spectator craft to the Secretary, Royal Lyminster Yacht Club, Bath Road, Lyminster, Hampshire.
