The selection committee included Phil Crebbin, who presented the Cup in 1984 for the purpose of giving young promising helmsmen who are outside the match racing circuit a chance to compete. The Helmsmen are: Glyn Charles - (20) 1985 British National Laser Champion. Currently campaigning a Soling with the 1988 Olympics in mind; Jon Ellis - (23) 1984 Firefly National Champion, 1985

winner of Westerly Crebbin Cup (but unable to compete in Westerly Royal Lymington Cup); Lawrence Mead - (24) 1981 J24 British Champion. 1983 helmsman/skipper of winning yacht in All Japan IOR championships; Jonathan Money - (28) 1984 helmsman of half tonner 'Scorpio' 1985 winner of Royal Cornwall Yacht Club match racing event; Ian Southworth - (24) 1983, '84 and '85 Endeavour Cup Champion of Champions. 1985 420 National Champion. Crew member 'Panda' in Southern Cross Series; Roger Yeoman - (28) 1985 third in International 14's World Championship. Second in Flying Dutchman National Championship.
