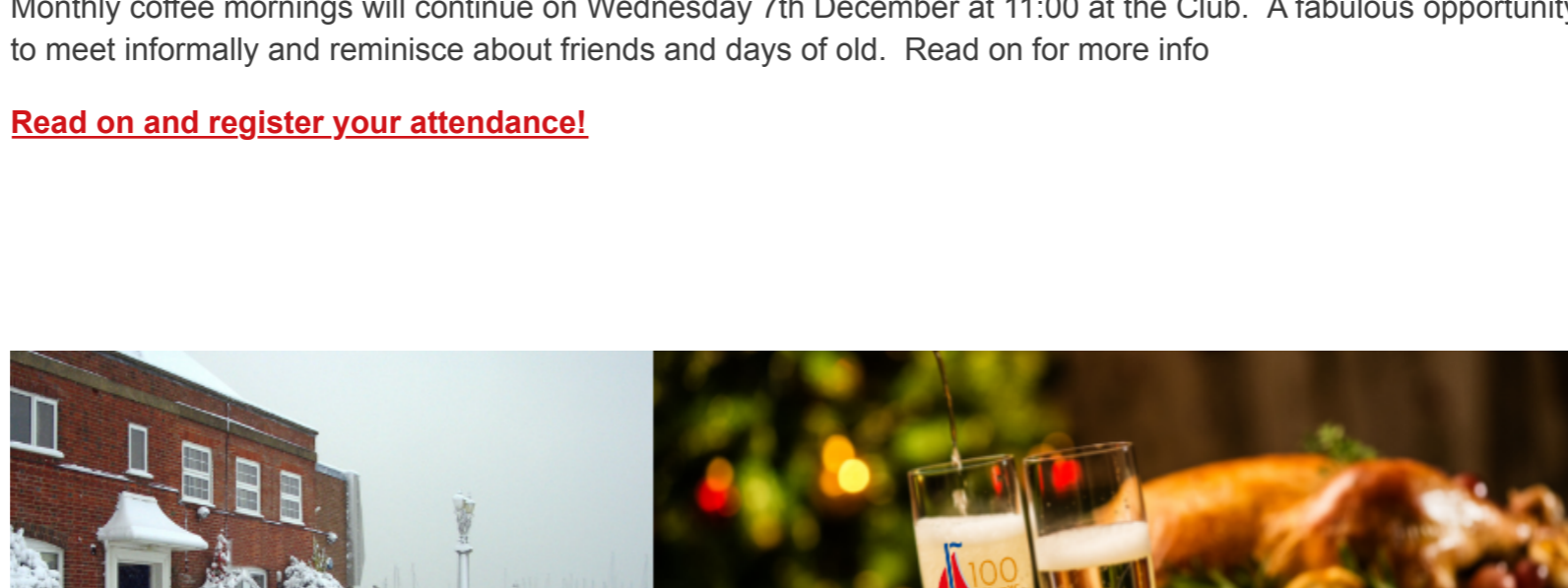


## RLymYC Historian Coffee Mornings

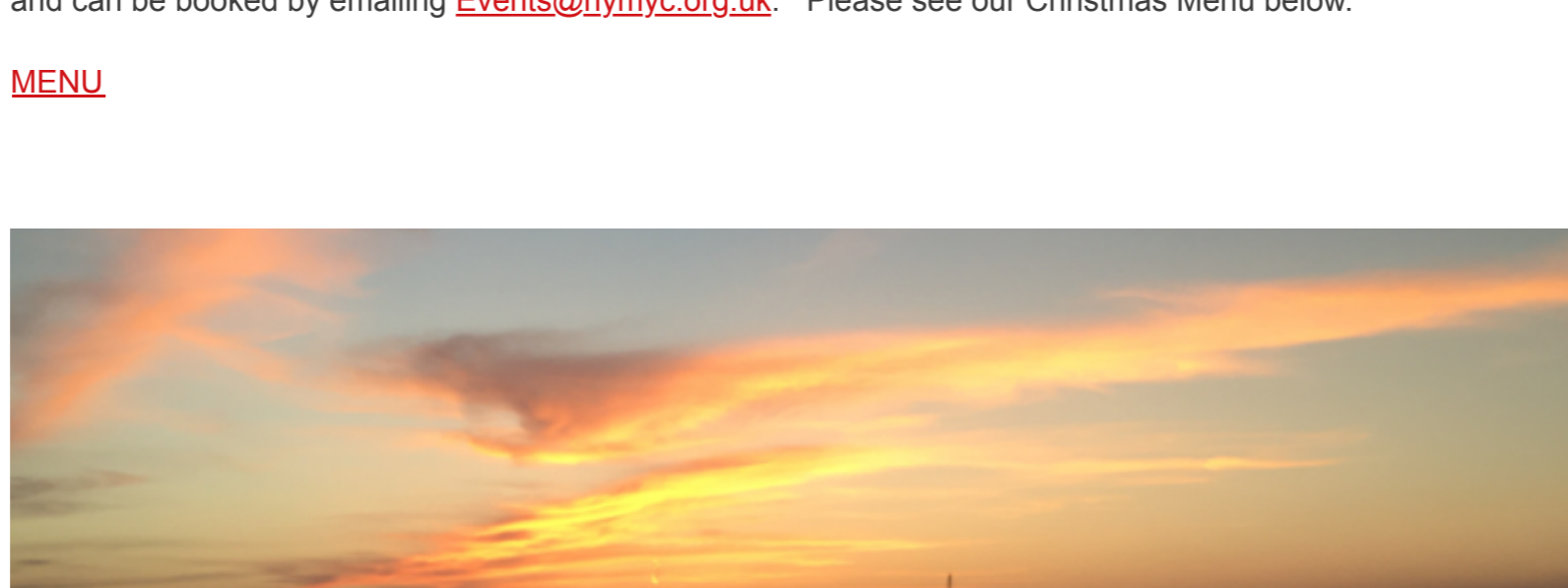

Judging and Lecture in the Club Wednesday February 1st 2023 at 18.30pm

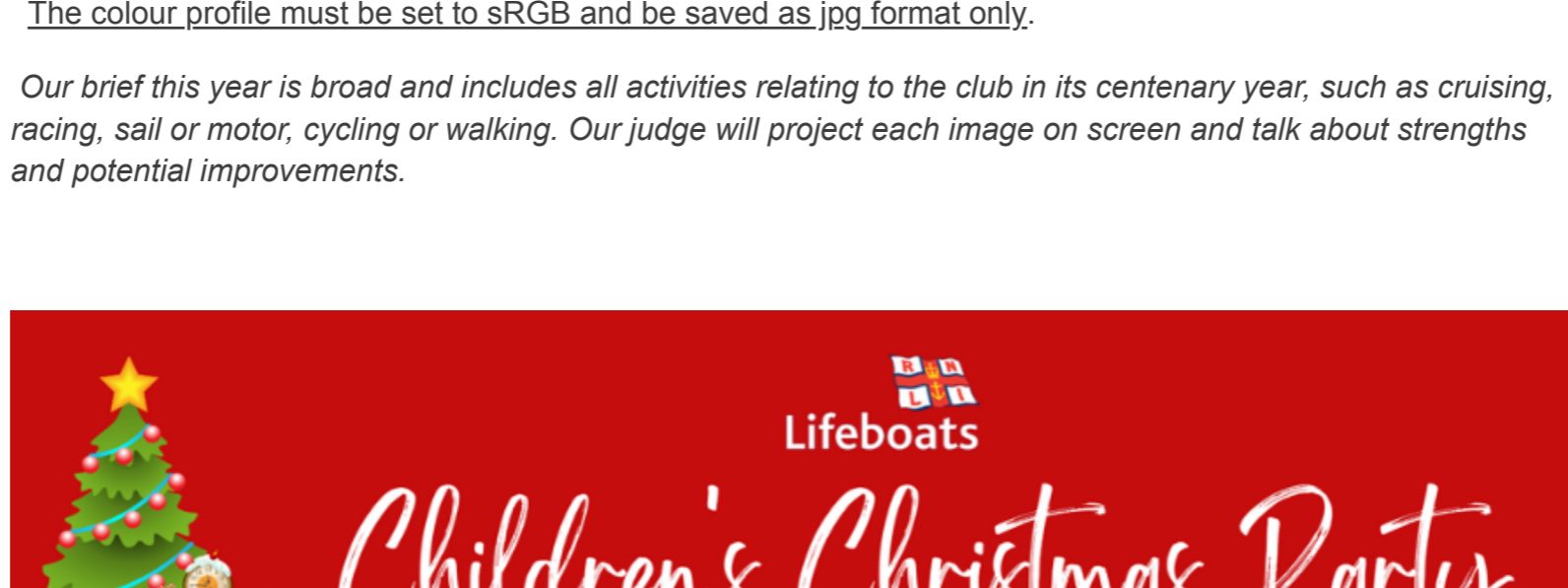
It's time for all members to start preparing an entry for this year's Photography Competition. The plan is to run the evening again as a digital competition.

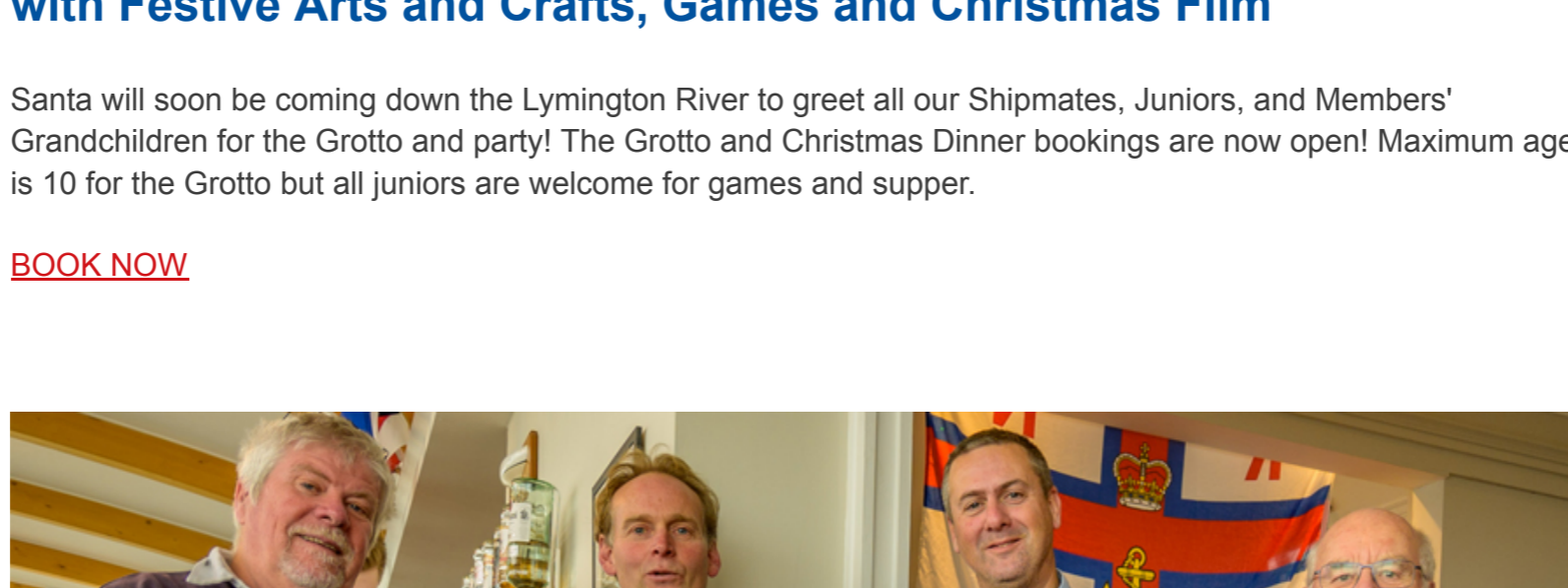
## Children's Party and Santa's Grotto

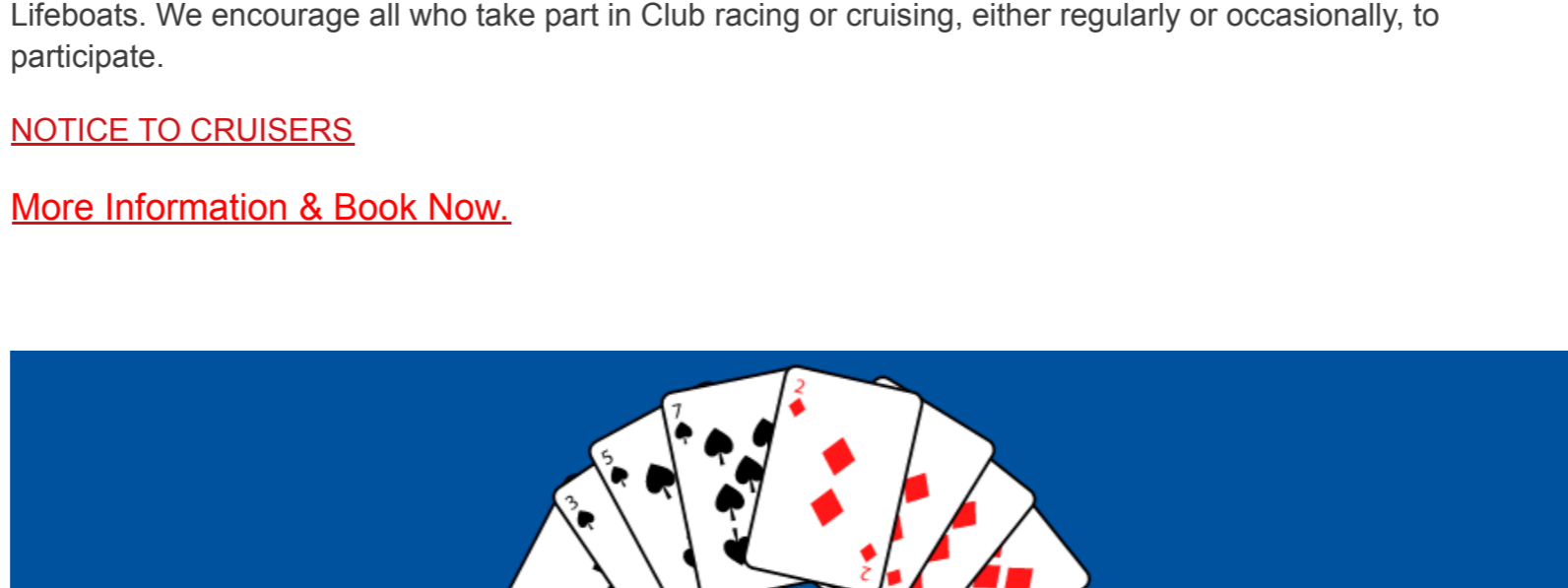
## Needles Relief 2022

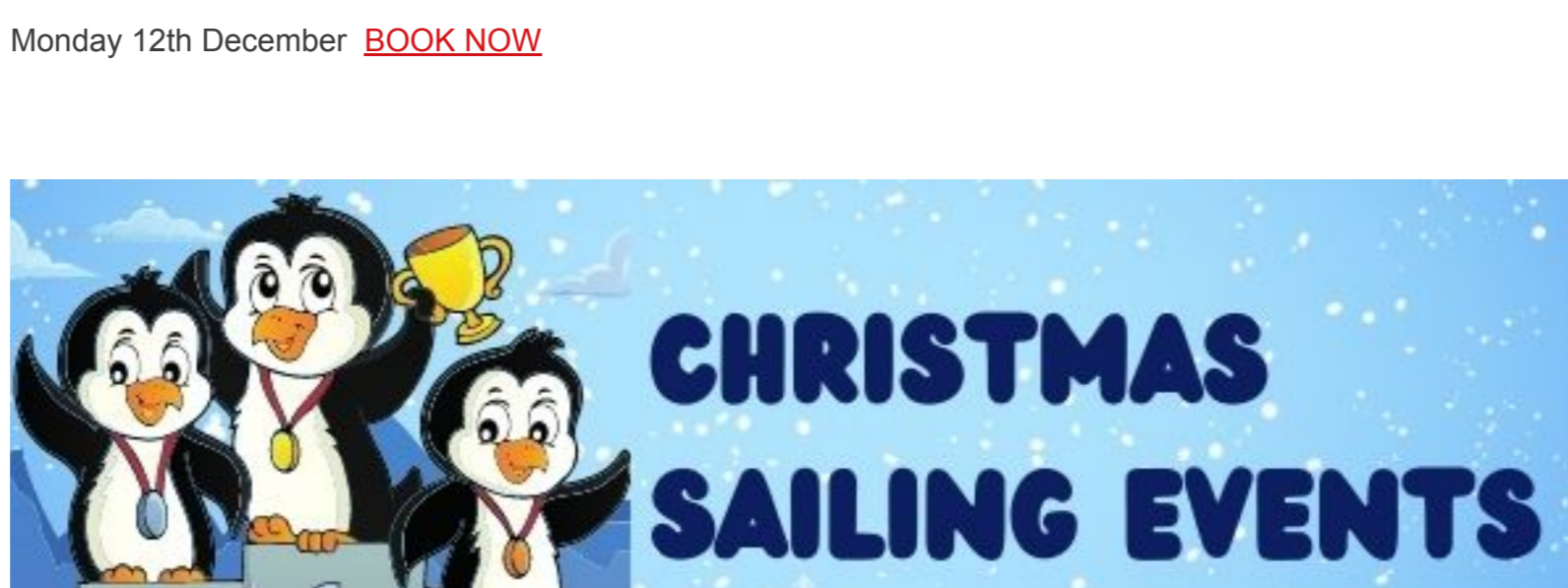


## BRIDGE SUPPER NIGHTS

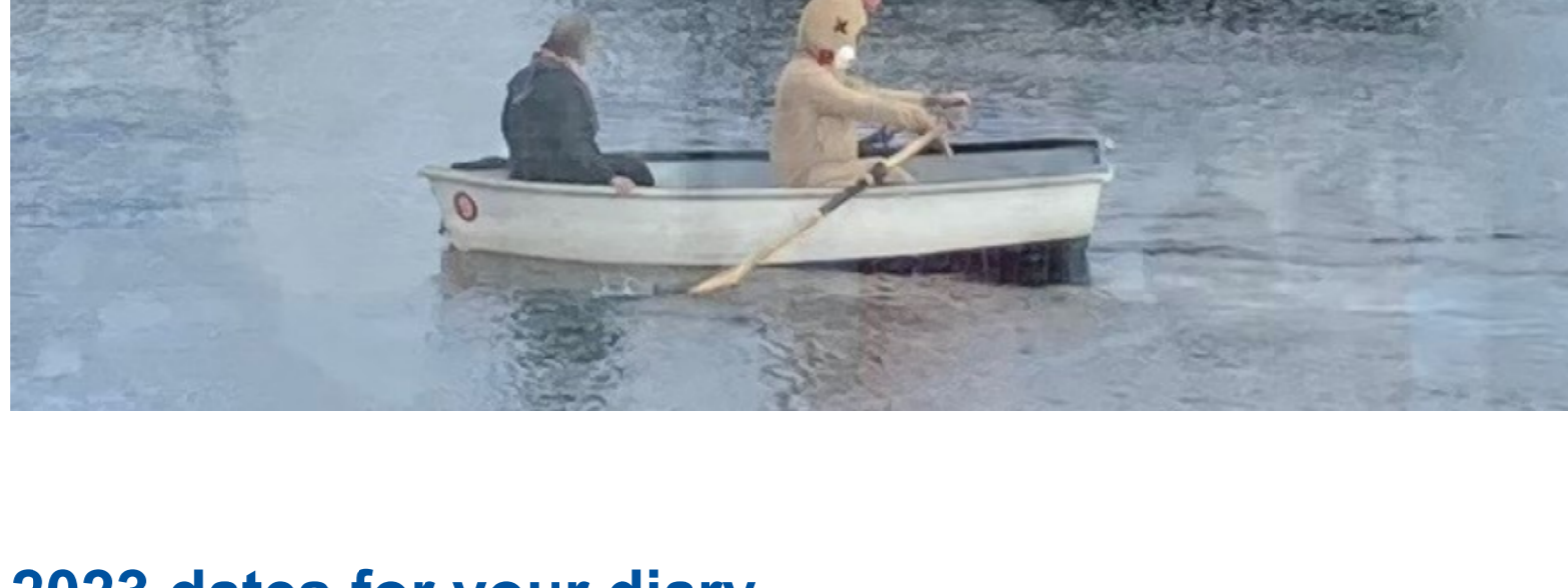
## New Year's Day Brunch

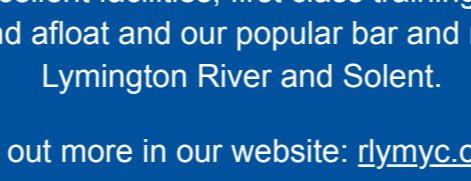
