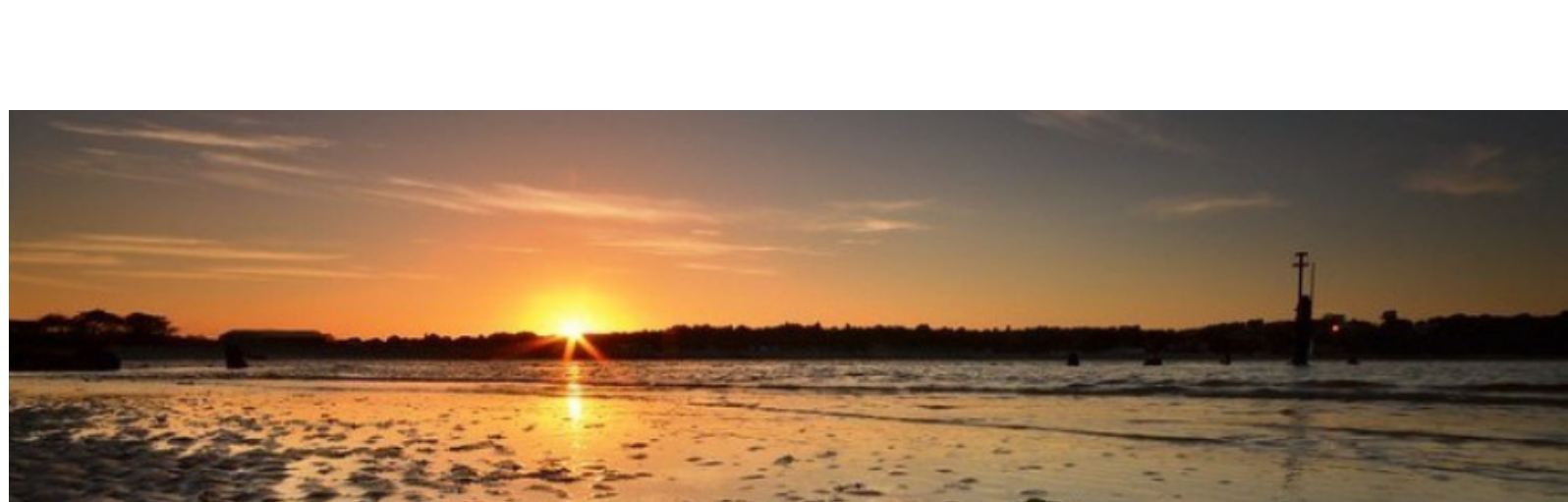


Informal Cruising Supper

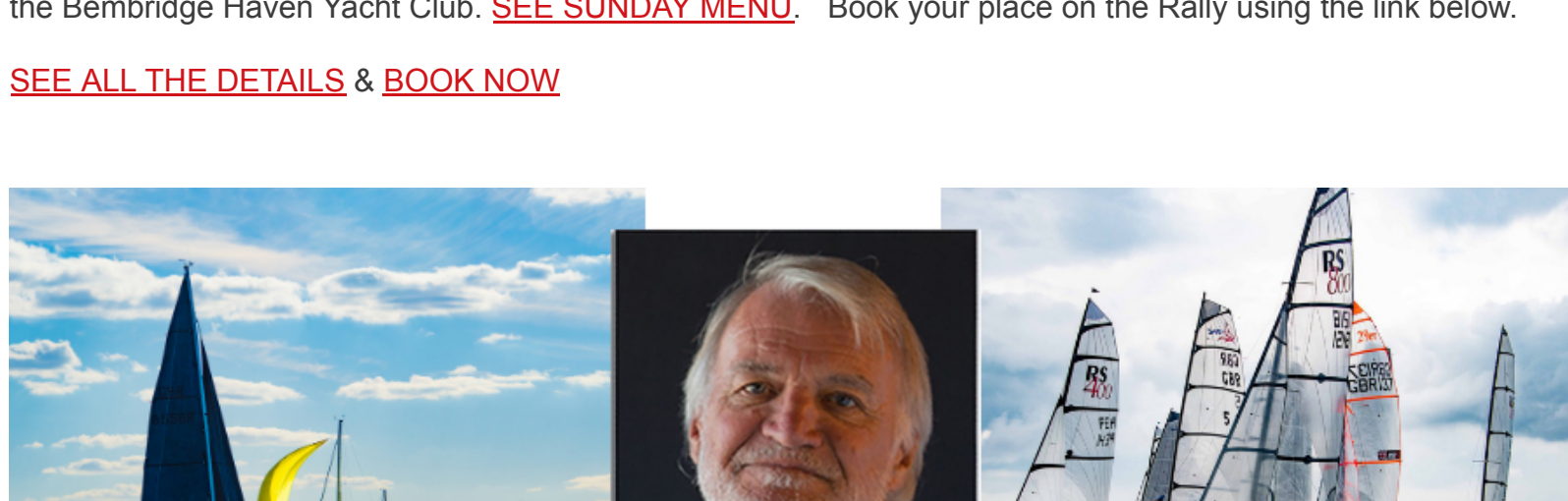


Bank Holiday Weekend Rally to Bembridge

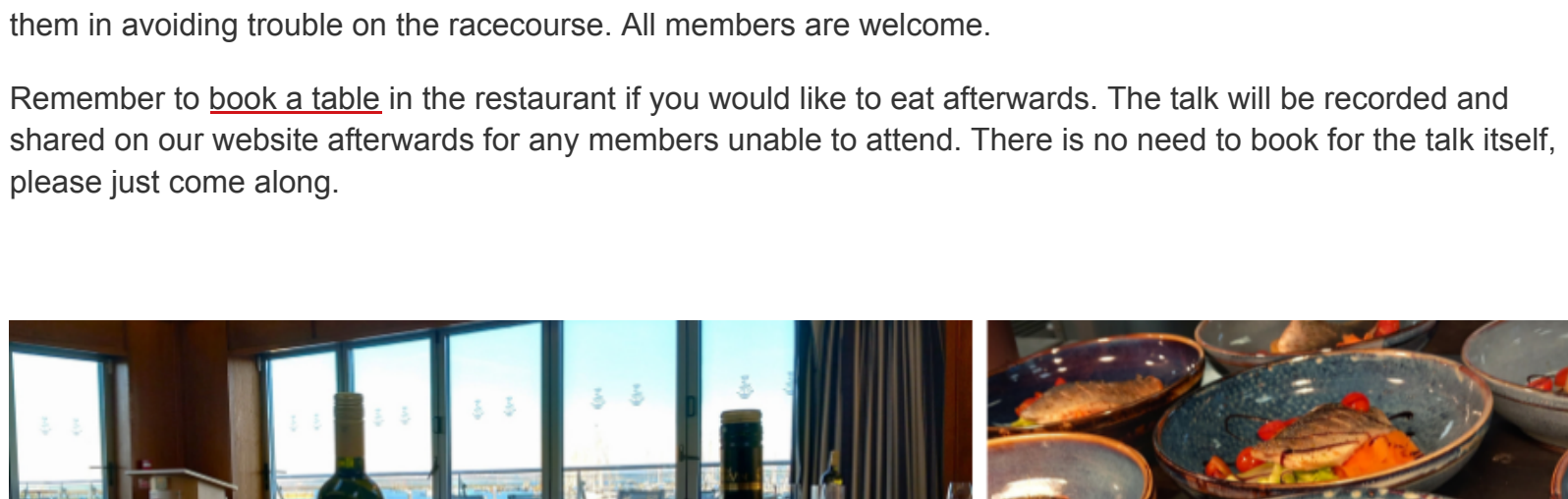


Rules of Racing Talk with John Doerr

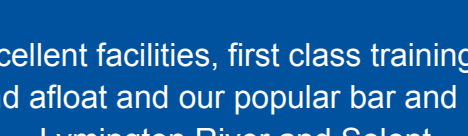
