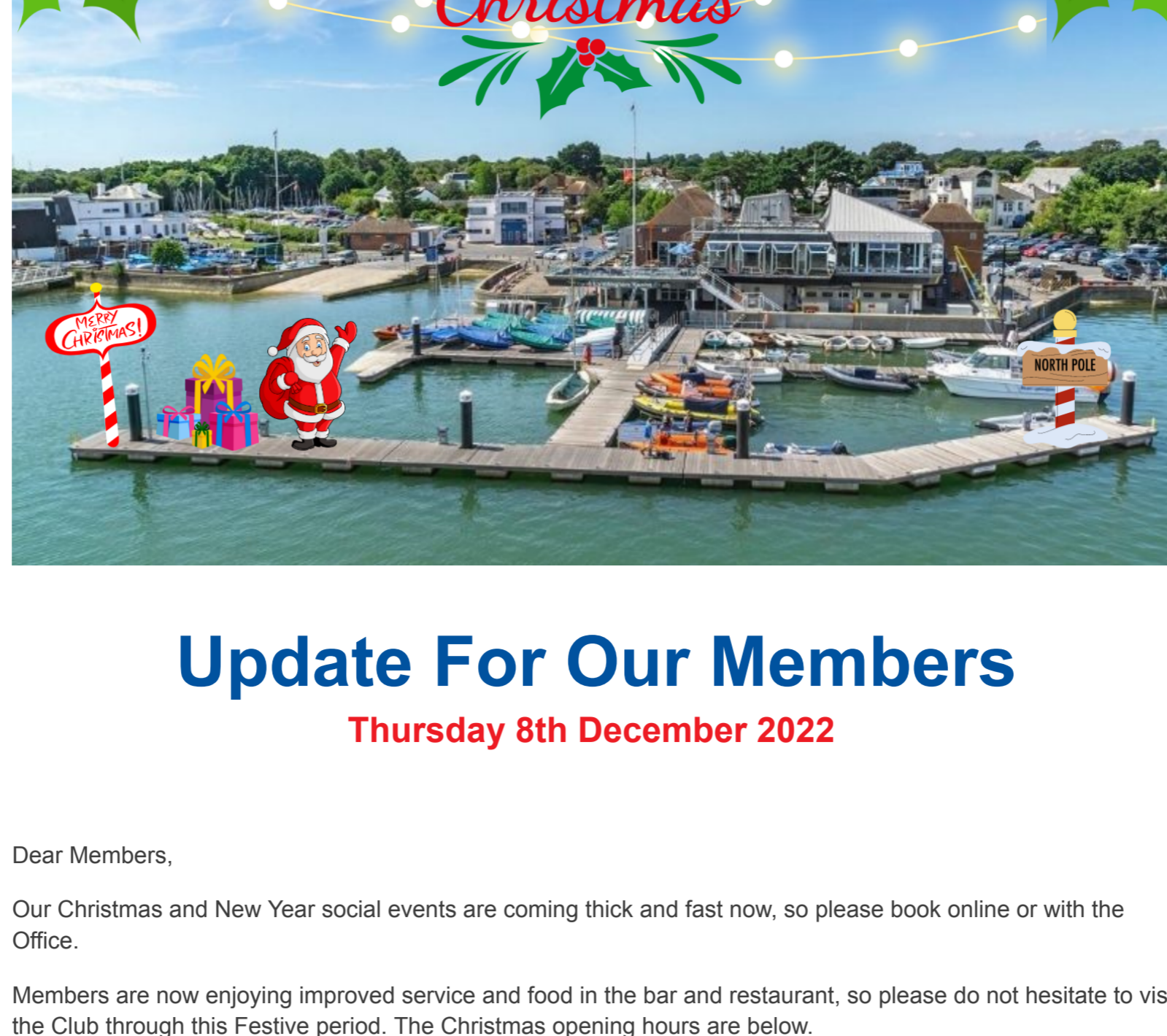

Dear Members,

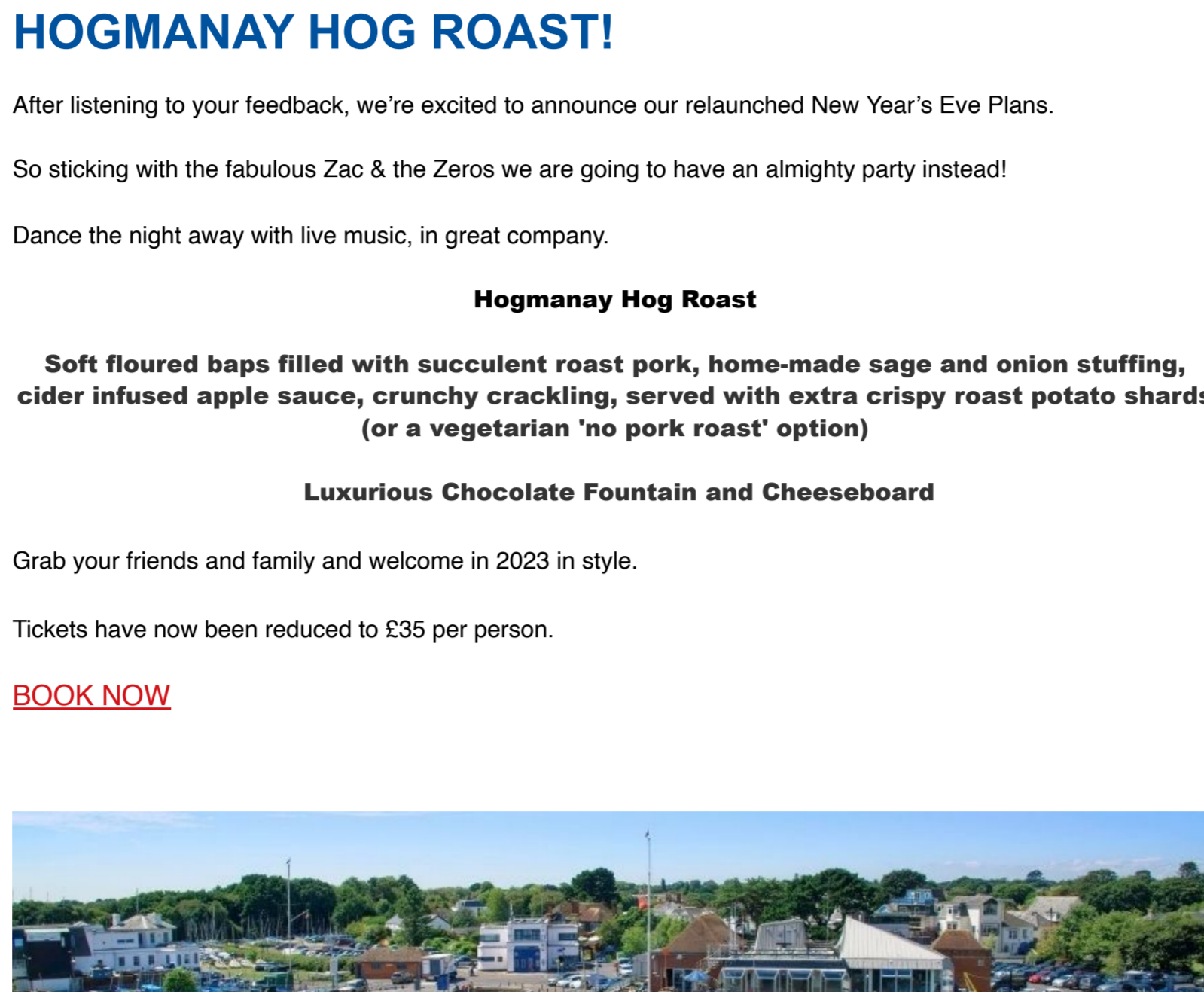
Our Christmas and New Year social events are coming thick and fast now, so please book online or with the Office.

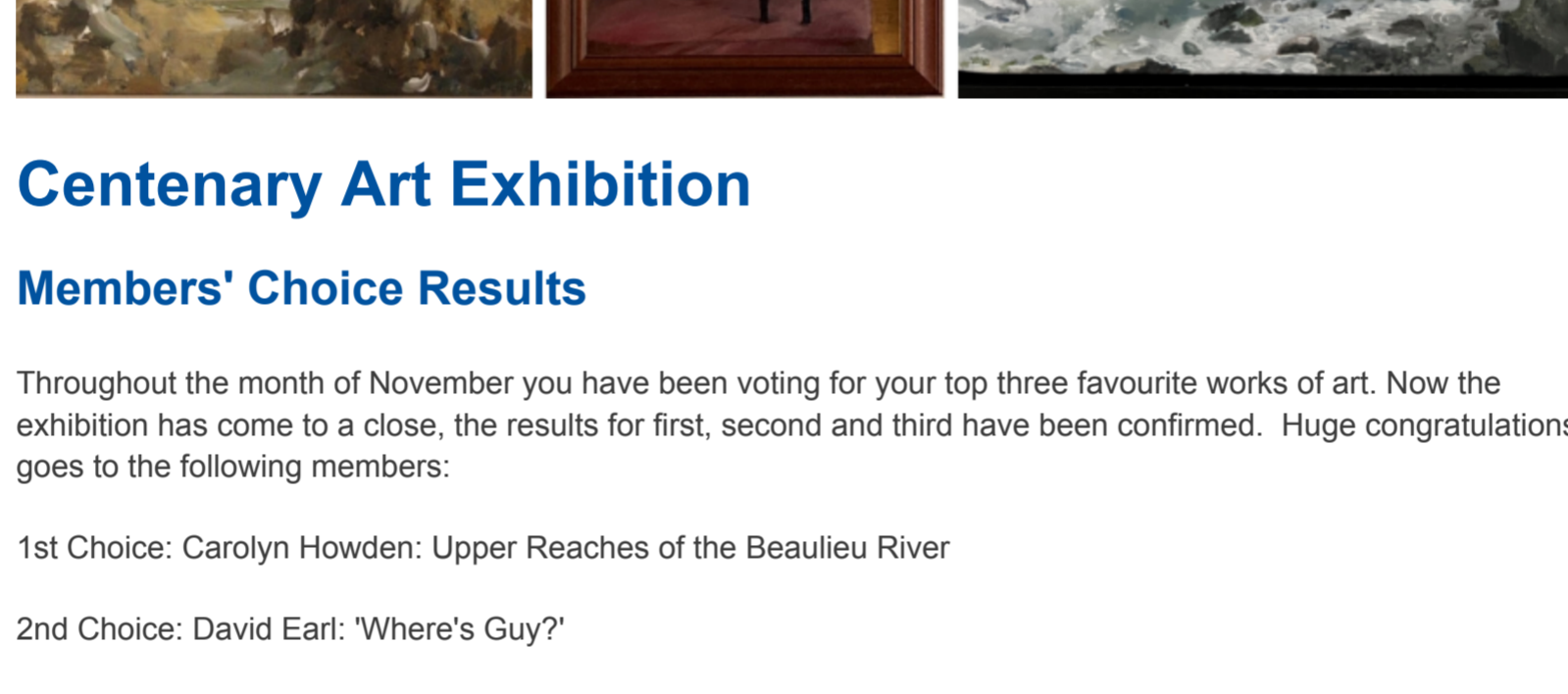

## Centenary Art Exhibition

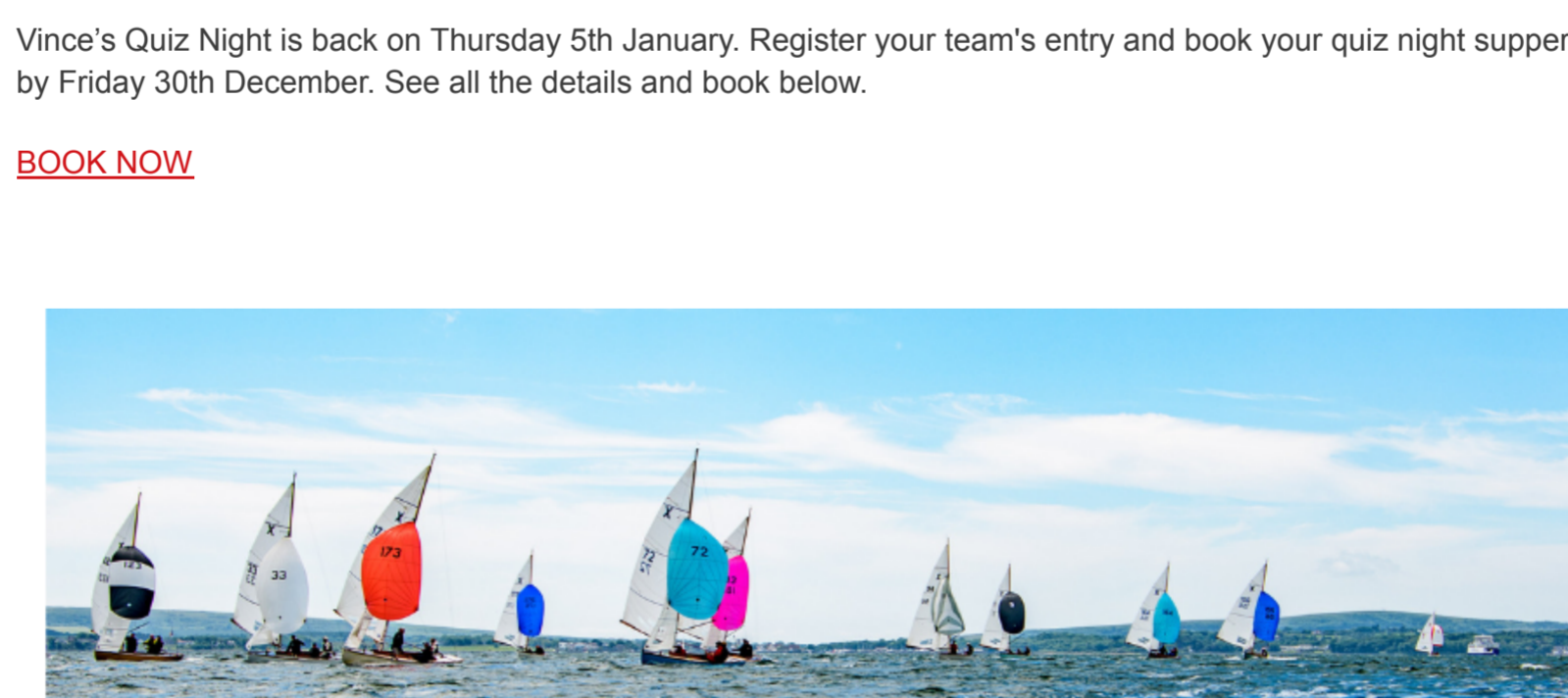
### Members' Choice Results

Judging and Lecture in the Club Wednesday February 1st 2023 at 18.30pm

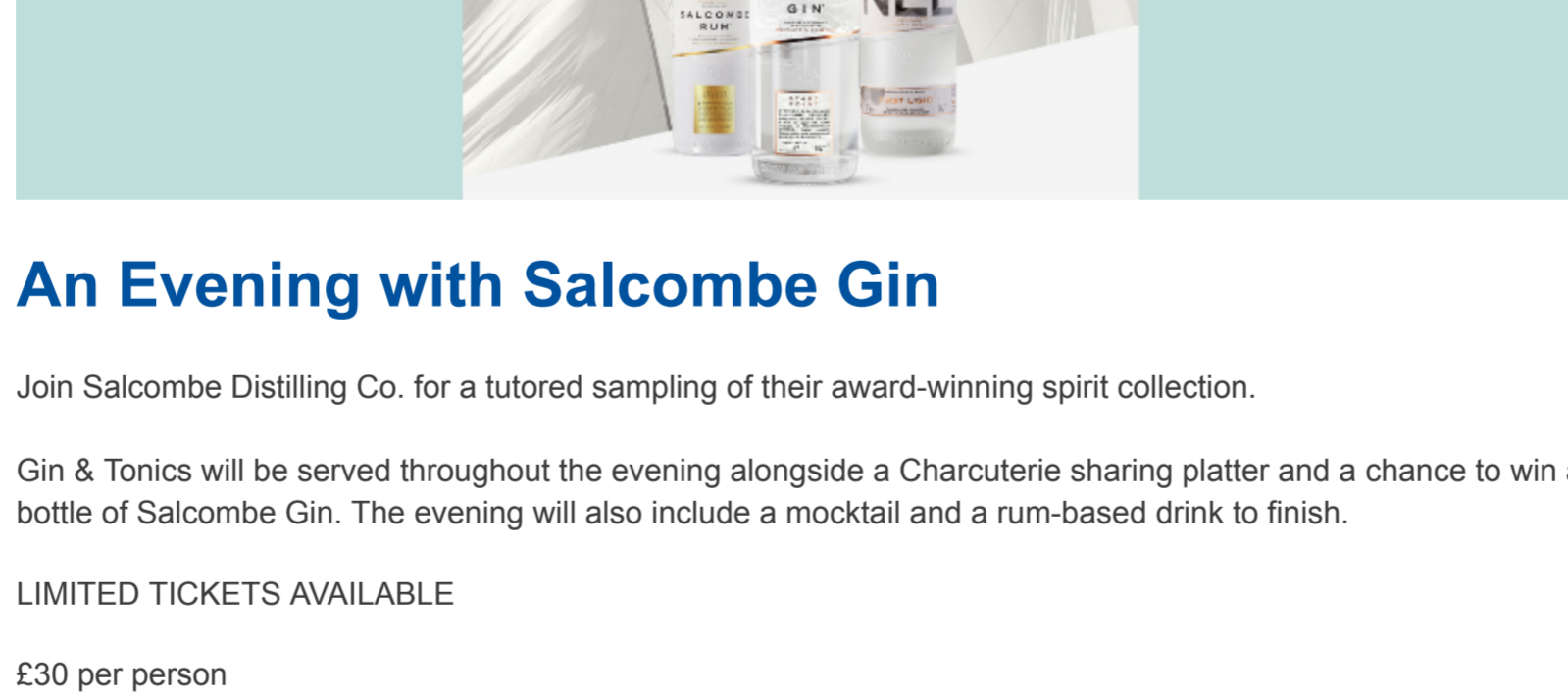
It's time for all members to start preparing an entry for this year's Photography Competition. The plan is to run the evening again as a digital competition.

### 'The Search for Speed from the Bottom Up'

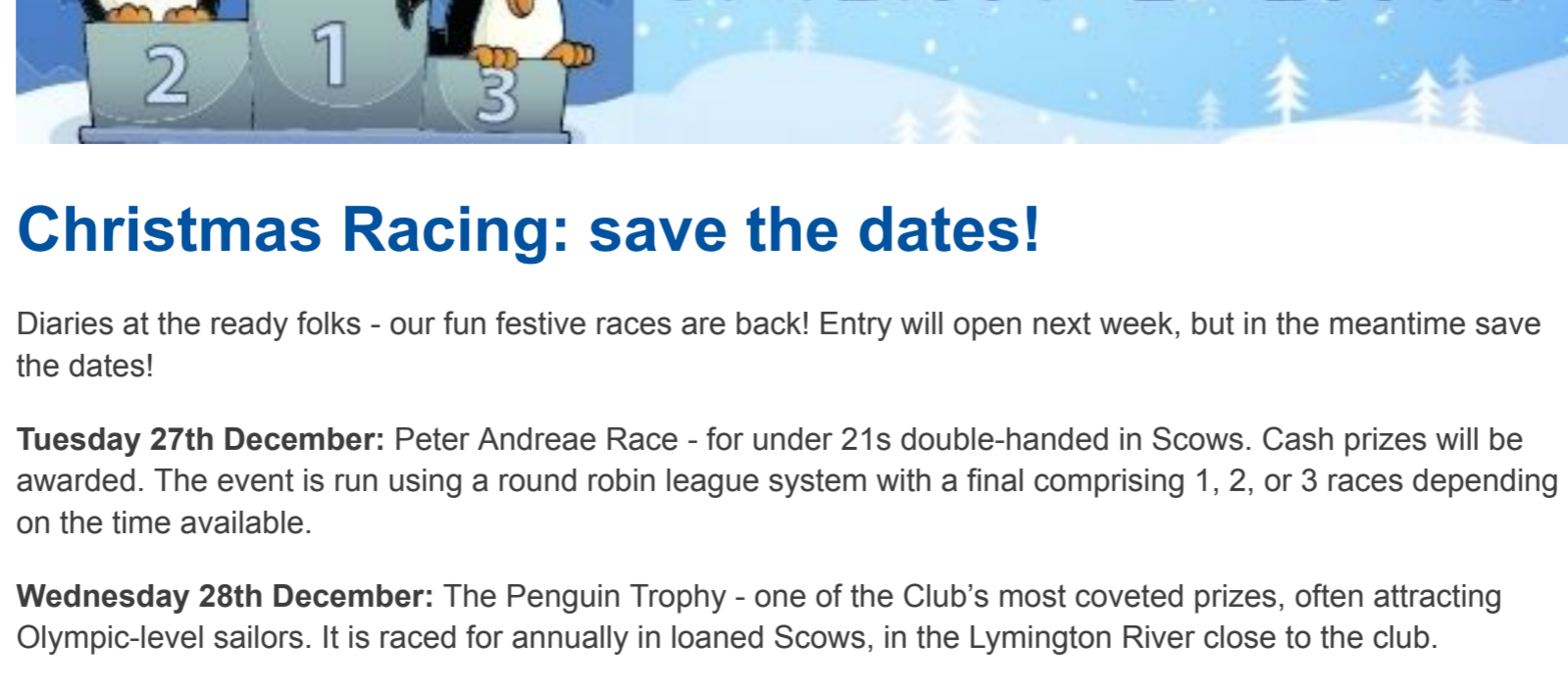

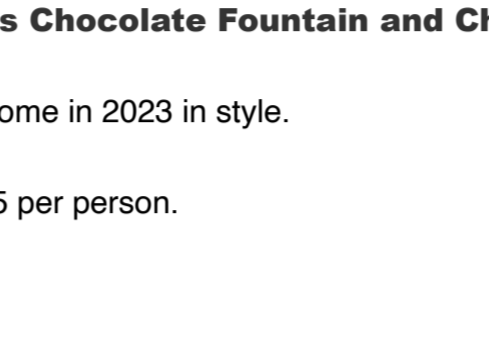
