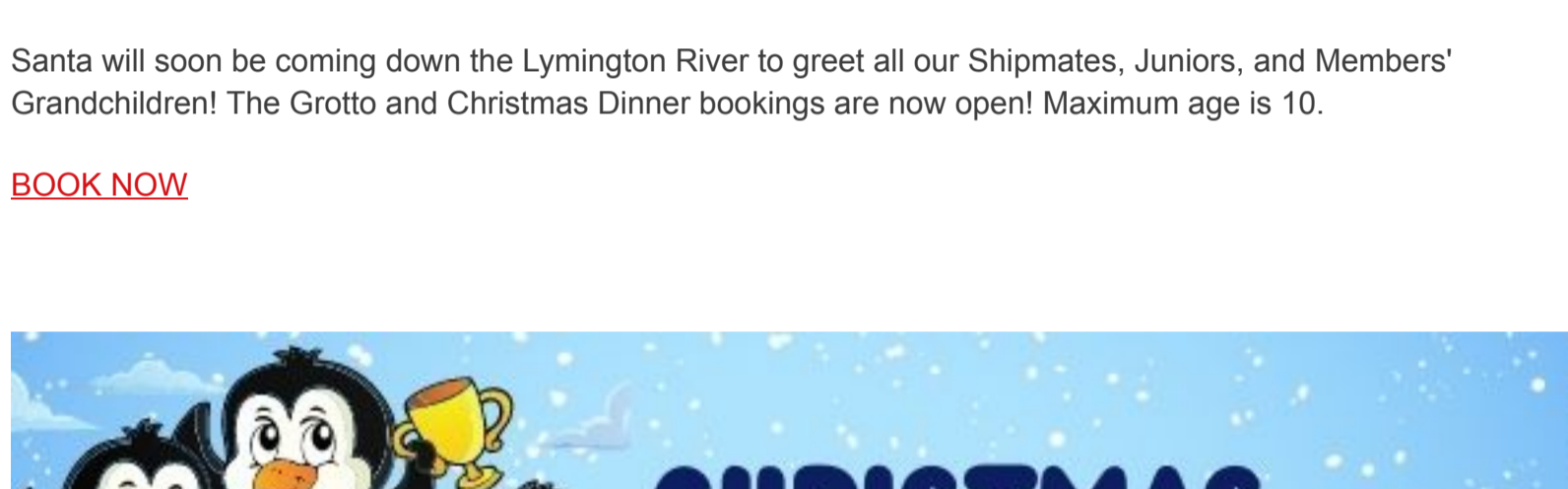


## Make Your Own Wreath

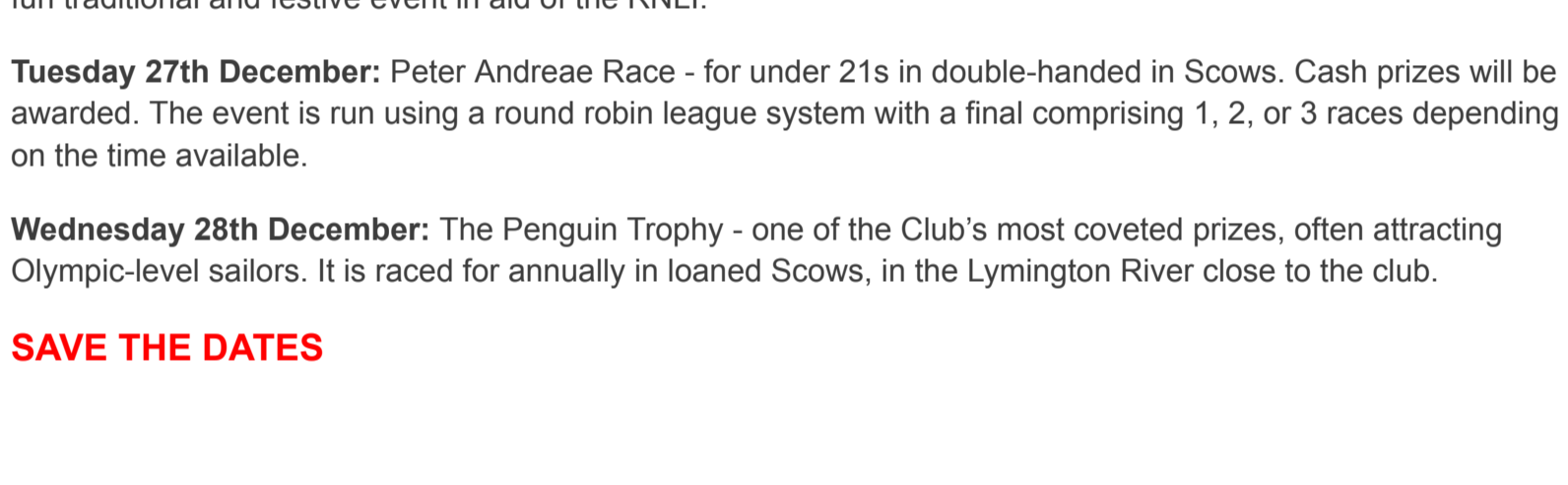

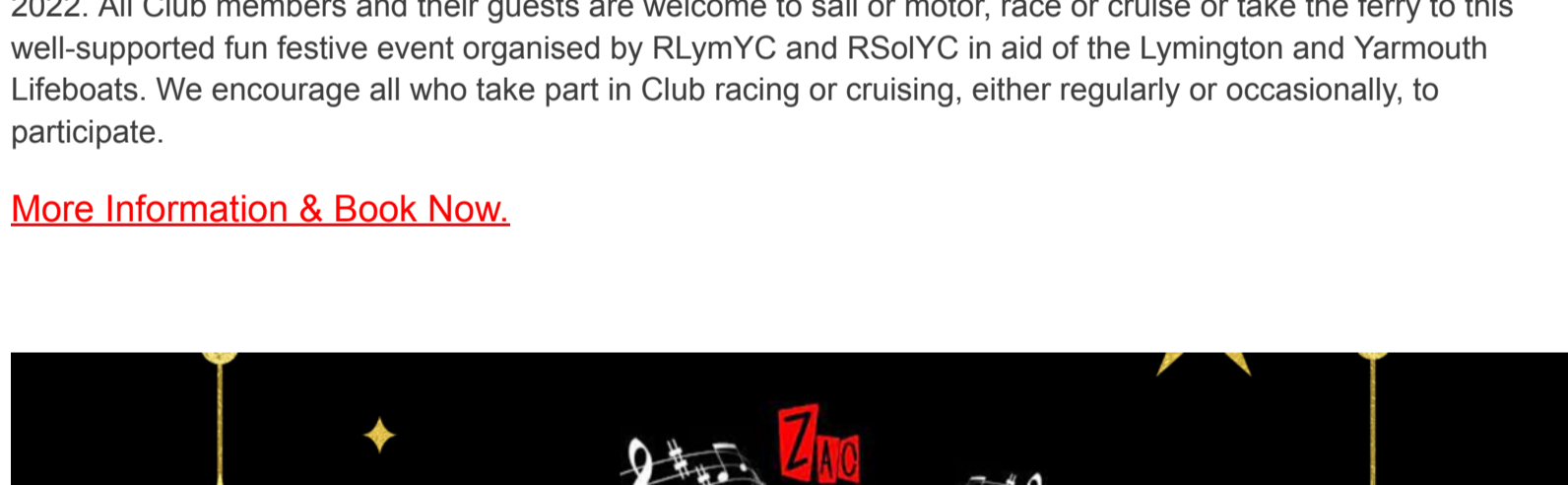
## Shipmates, Juniors, and Grandchildren

With Zac and the Zeros!

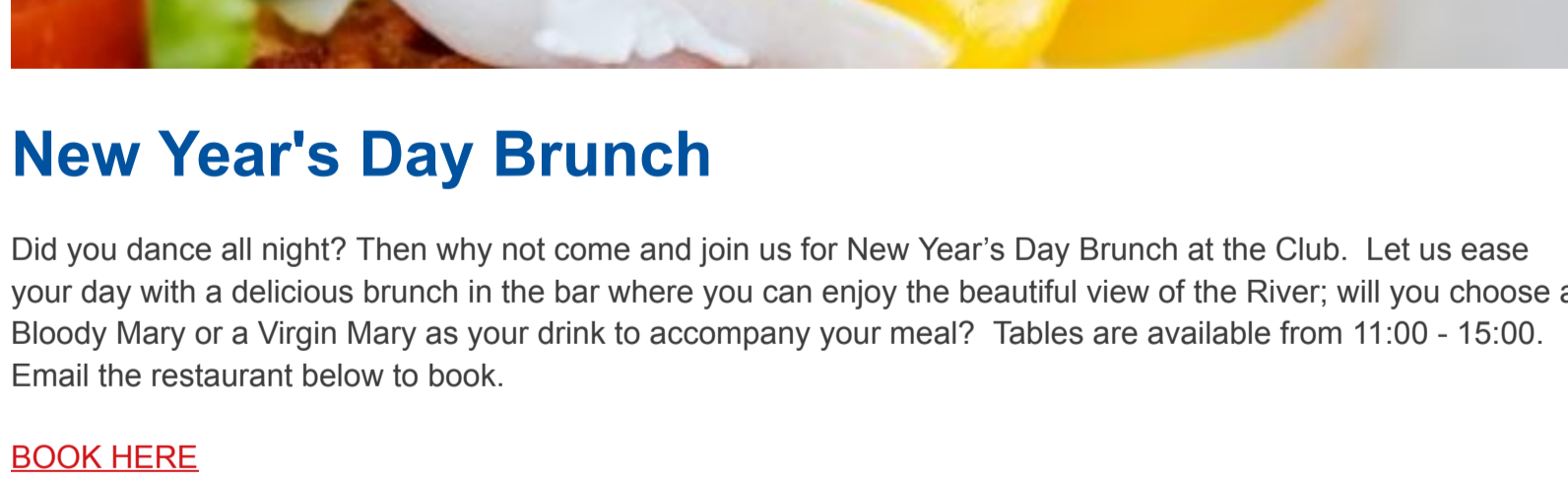
Join us in welcoming the New Year with music from Zac and the Zeros.

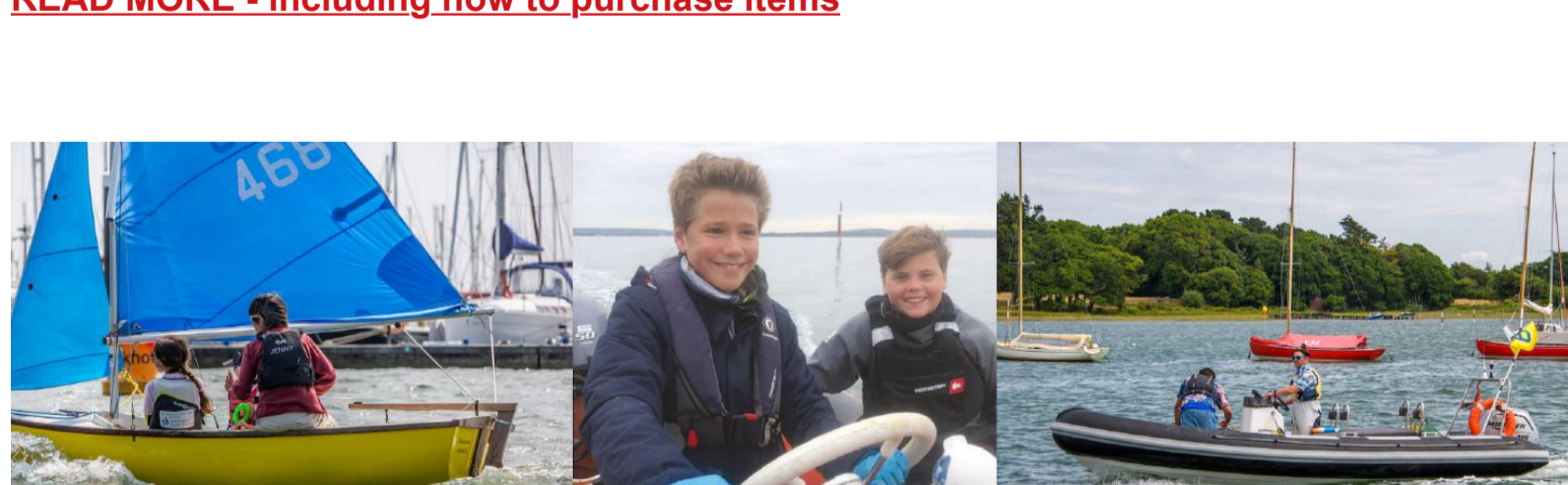
## Celebrating the Centenary

On Thursday 24th November at 18:30 we are running an evening for members to discuss their experiences of recovering people lost over the side whilst racing, with some professional input from an invited guest.

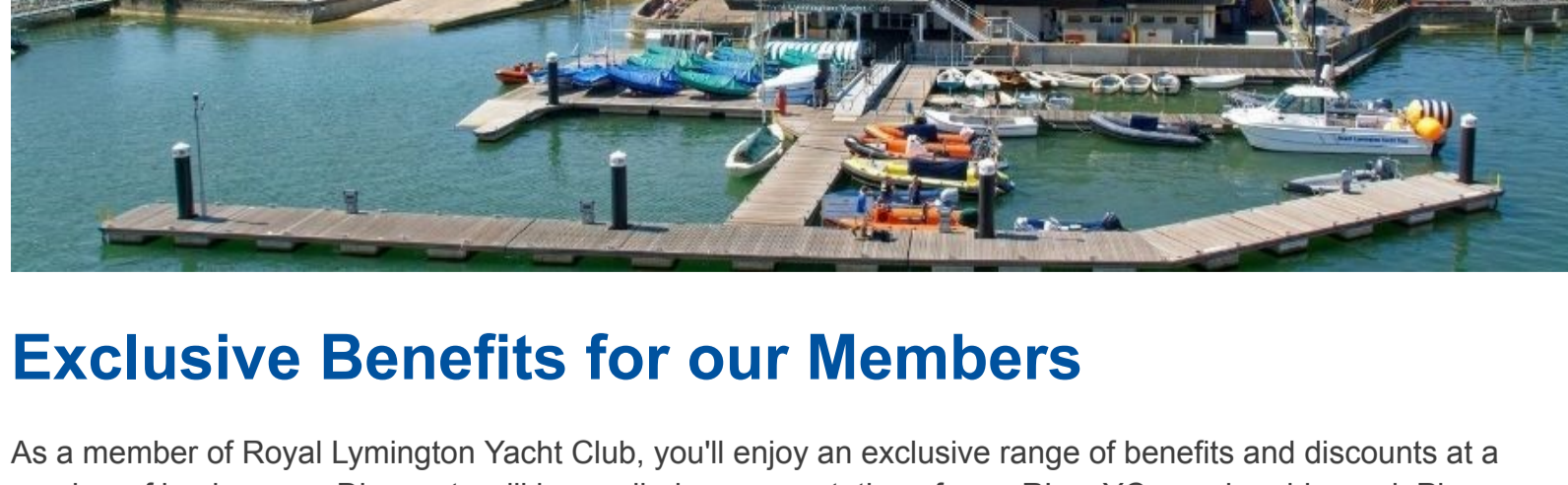

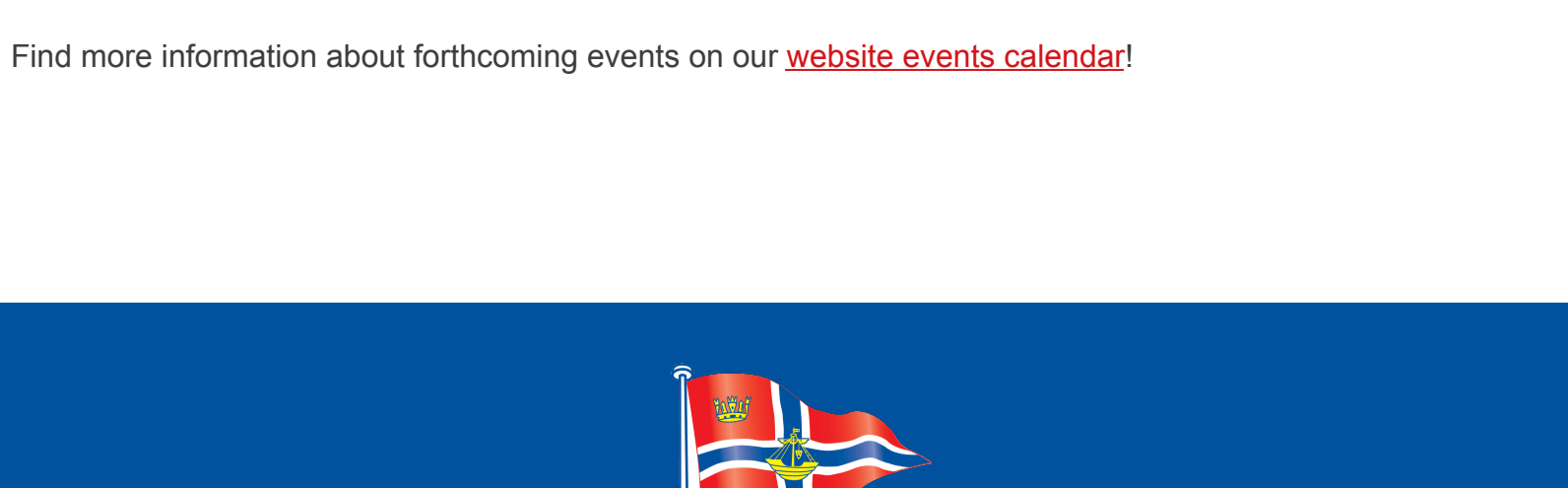
