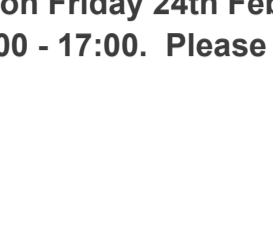
A small group, with equal diligence, will evaluate the responses and report their findings in a future Newsletter, hopefully in three weeks.

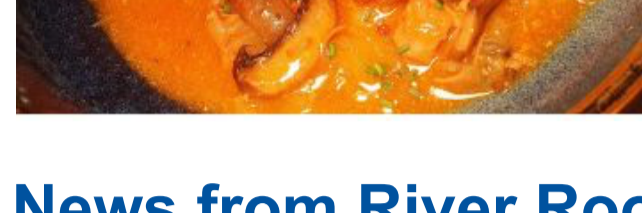
IT System Outage

With crisp flavours of apple, lemon, lime and white melon, it works well with lighter dishes, including prawns or salads from our Jib, Main & Genoa menus.

Crew Match 2023

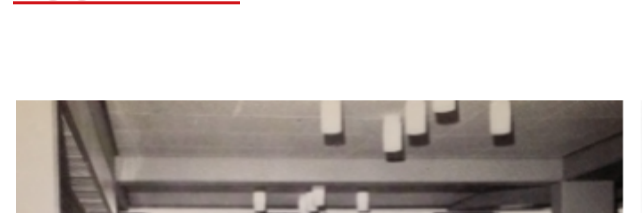
Saturday 11th March 10:00 - 12:00

Race Team Training

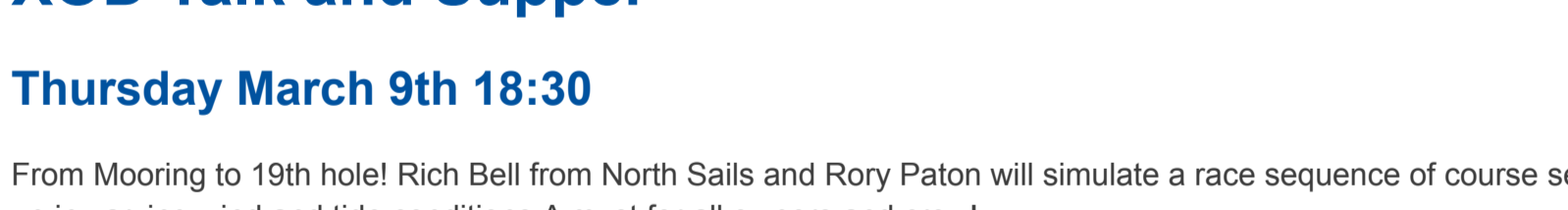

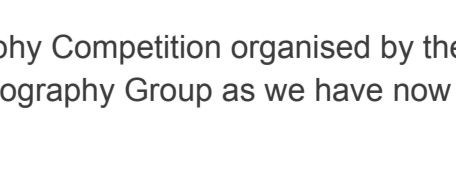
