Dear Members,

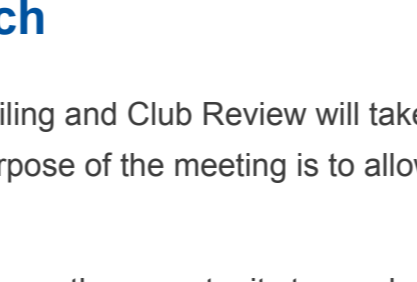

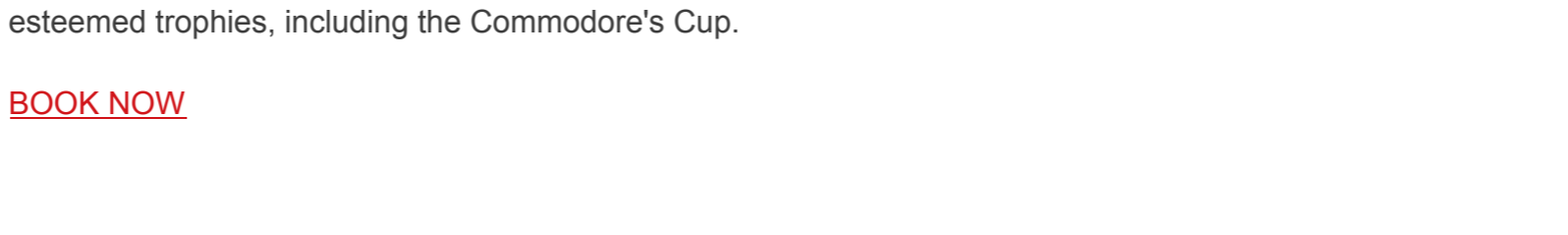

## Jeremy Rogers MBE

It is with much regret that we have to report the recent death of **Jeremy Rogers MBE** who passed away peacefully on Wednesday 12th October at the age of 85.

Local boat builder Jeremy joined the Club in 1954 and quickly established himself as a first-class yachtsman. His sailing achievements have included winning the One-Ton Cup, two successful Admiral's Cup series and he was named Yachtsman of the Year in 1974 after rescuing a family during an offshore race.

During his career he was responsible for the construction of many well-known yachts including the increasingly popular Contessa 26 and Contessa 32 which are still competitively sailed here at the Club today. He received his MBE from H.M the Queen for services to yachting in 1981.

A service of Thanks Giving will be held at St Thomas' Church on Thursday 8th December 2022 at 14:00hrs followed by a wake at the RLmYC.

We send our condolences to wife, Fiona, and his family at this sad time.

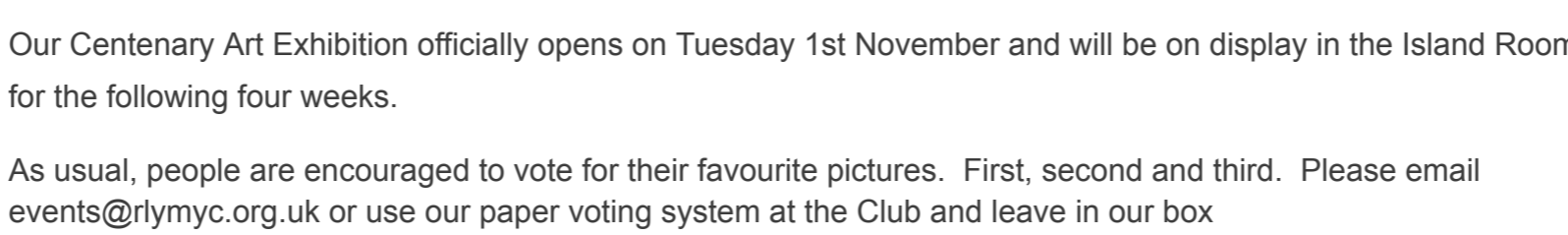

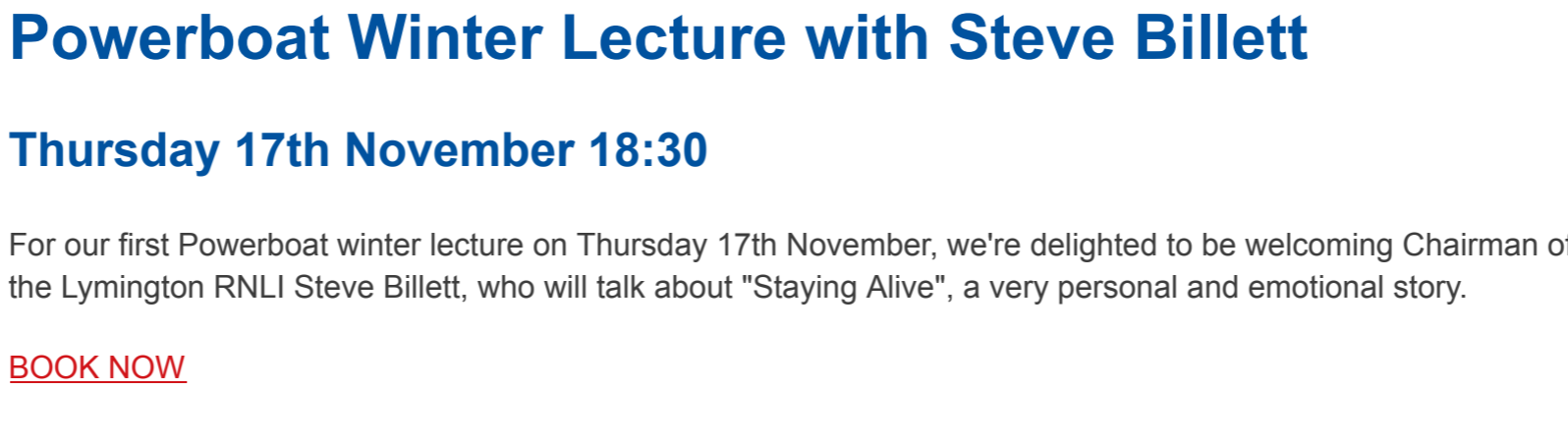


## Art Exhibition - Judged by Simon Chadwick

At the end of the exhibition, we'll tot up the votes and announce the winner.

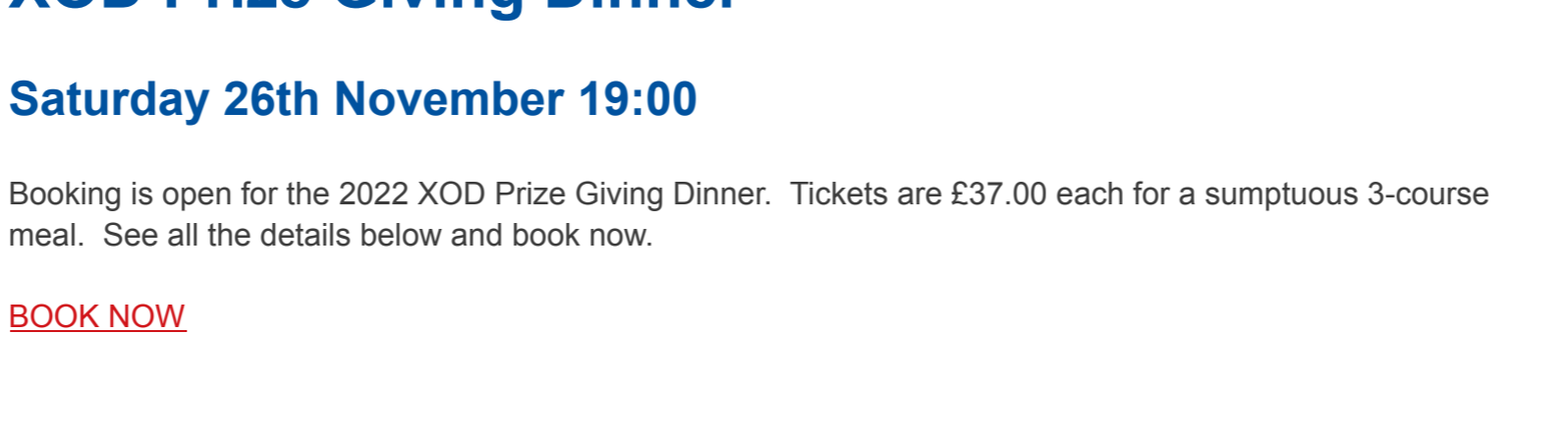


## Powerboat Winter Lecture with Steve Billett

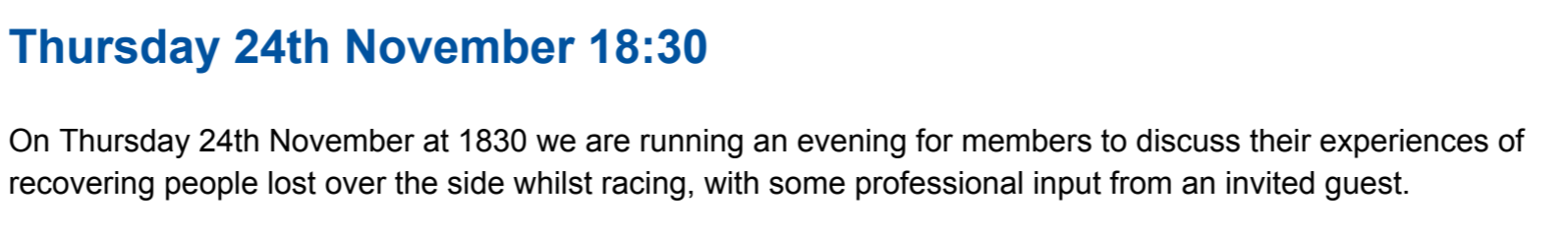

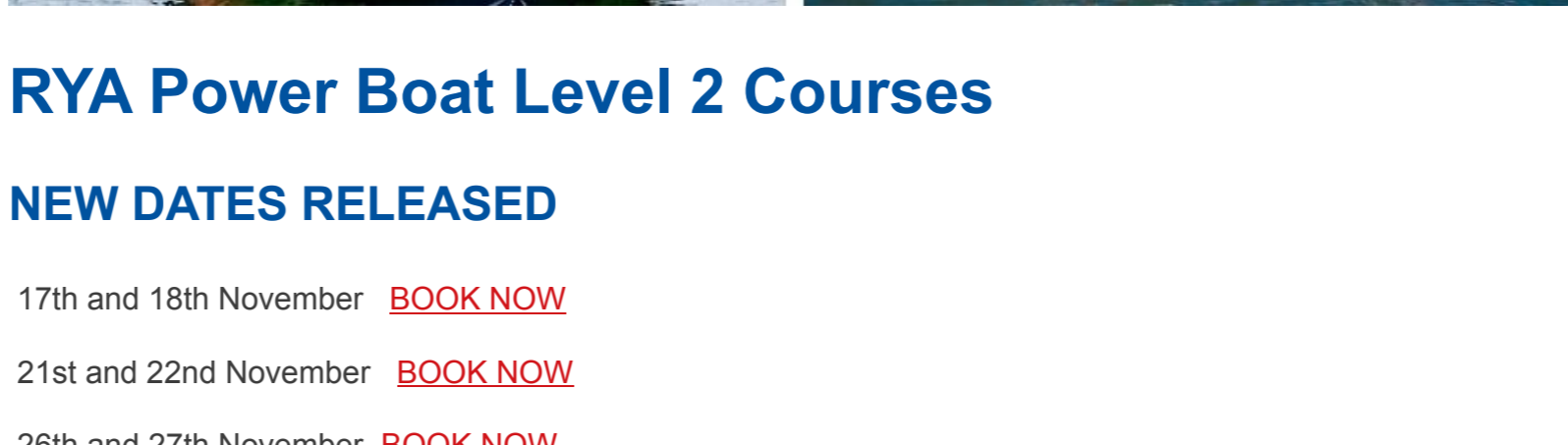


## Cruiser/Racer Open Forum

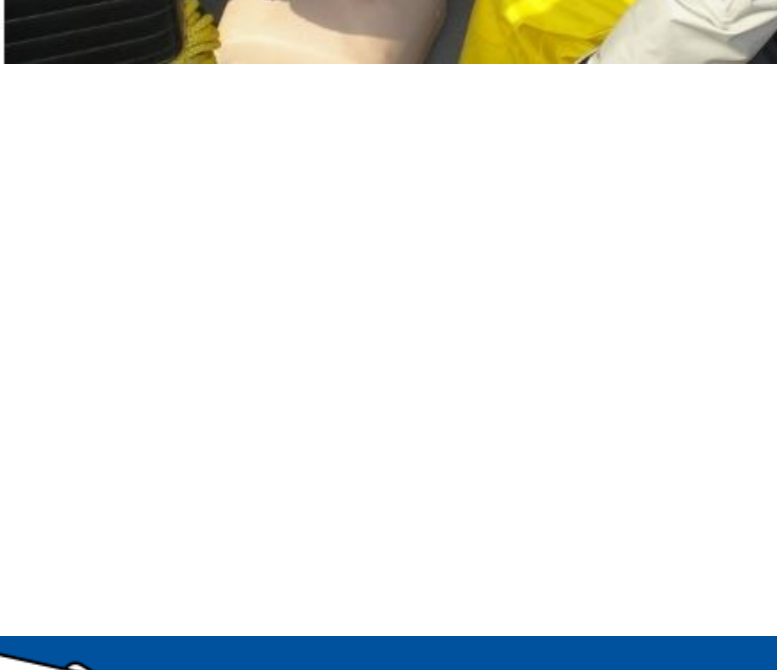

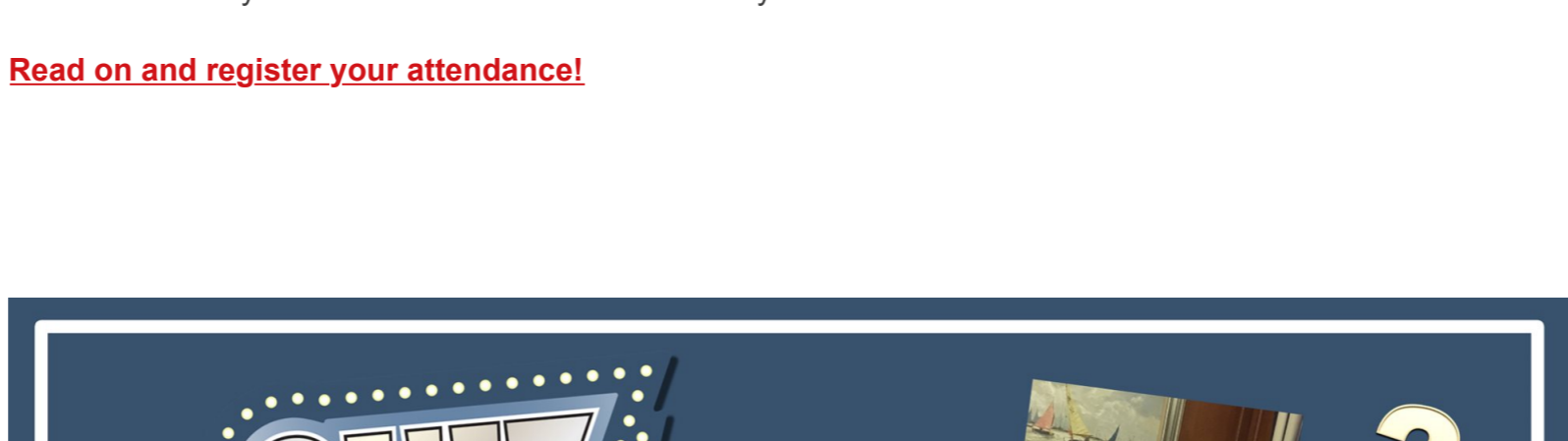
## BRIDGE SUPPER NIGHTS

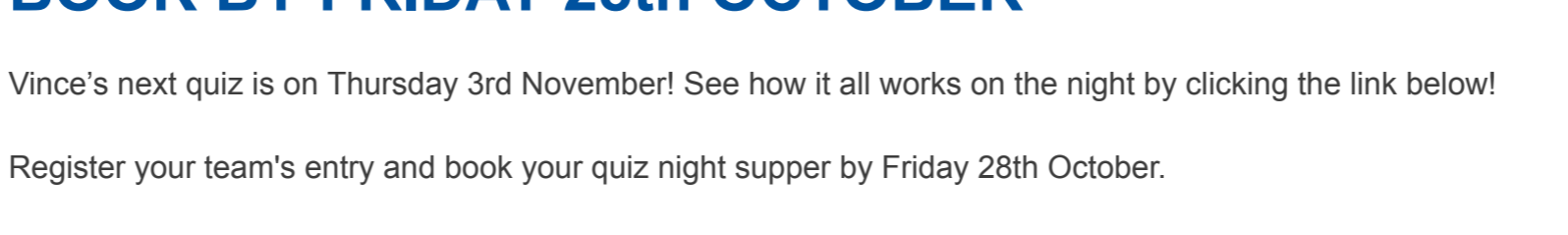

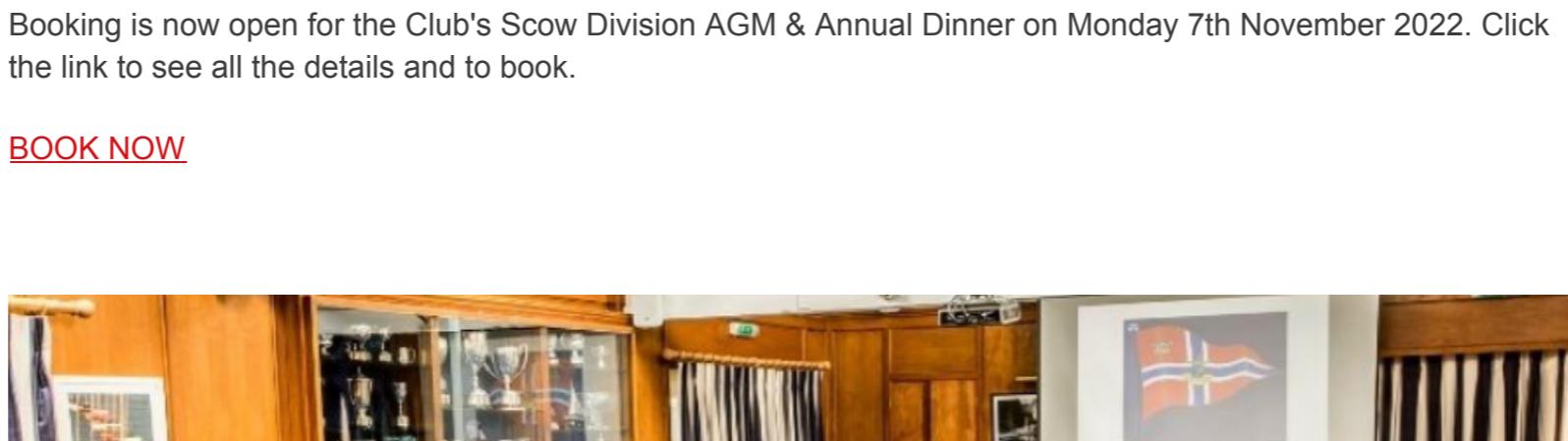

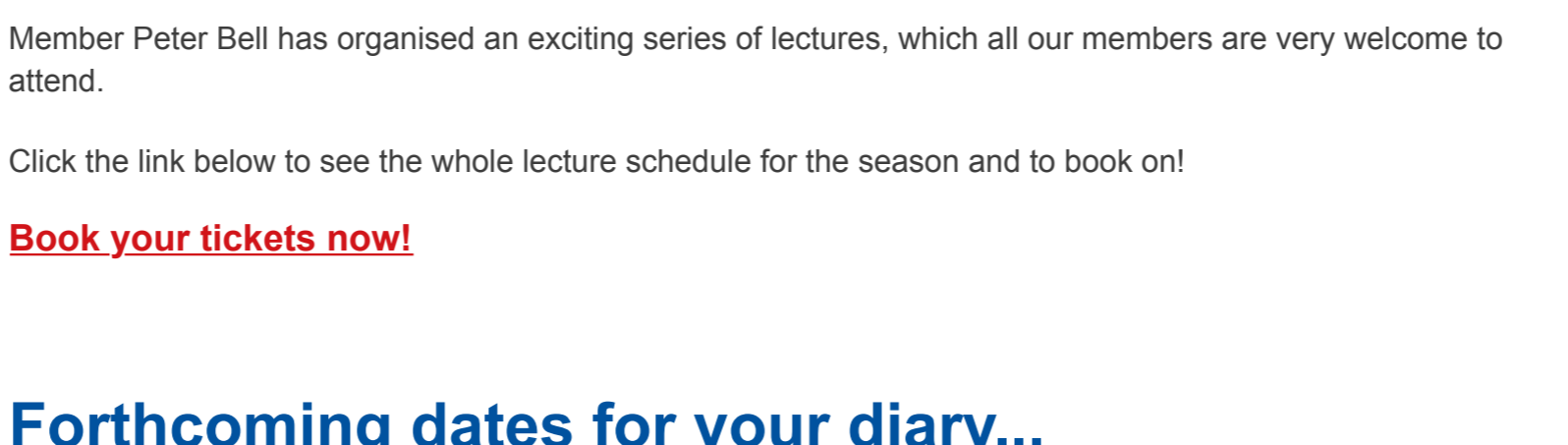
