Please accept our apologies for any inconvenience this may cause.



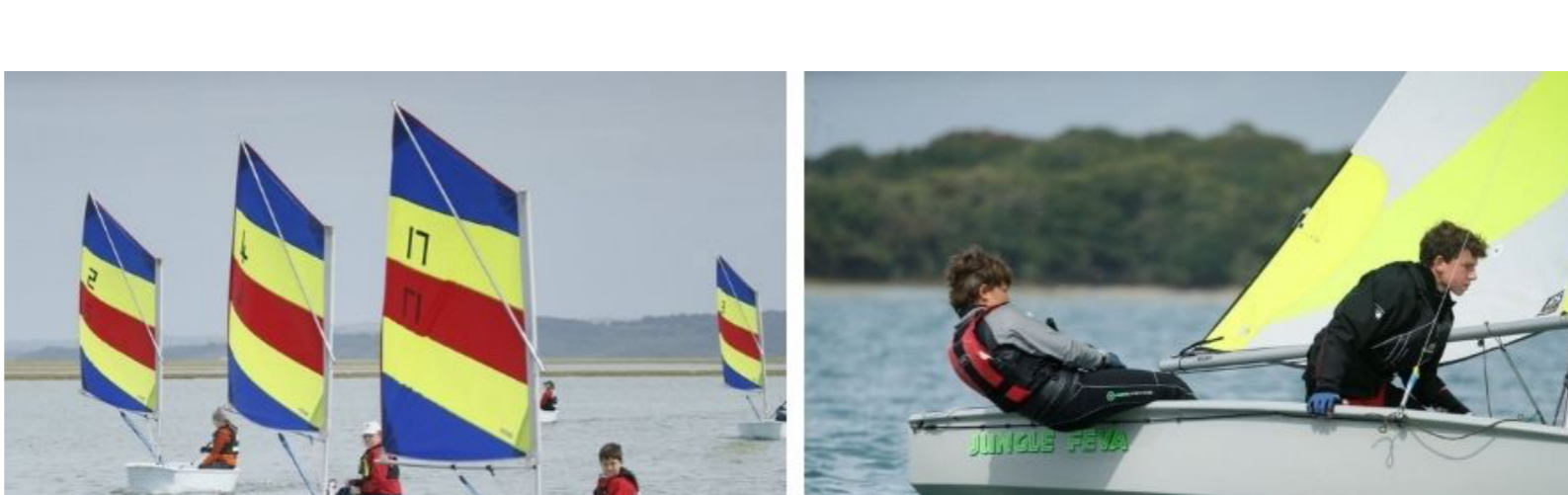
Centenary Party 3rd September 2022

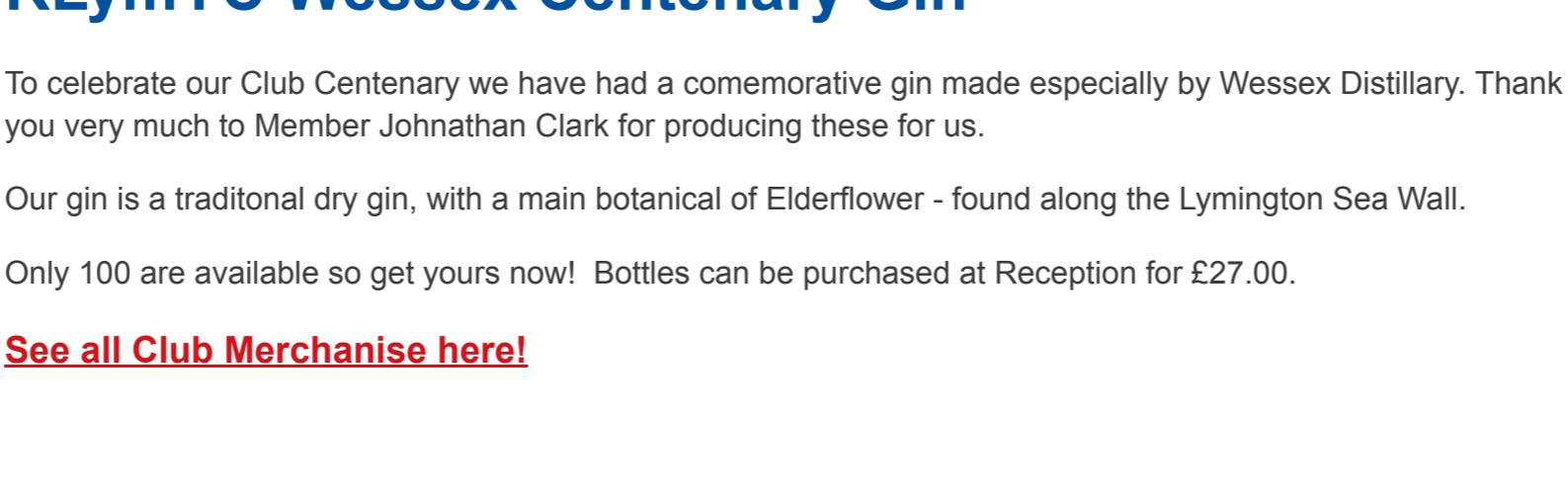
RLYMYC Wessex Centenary Gin

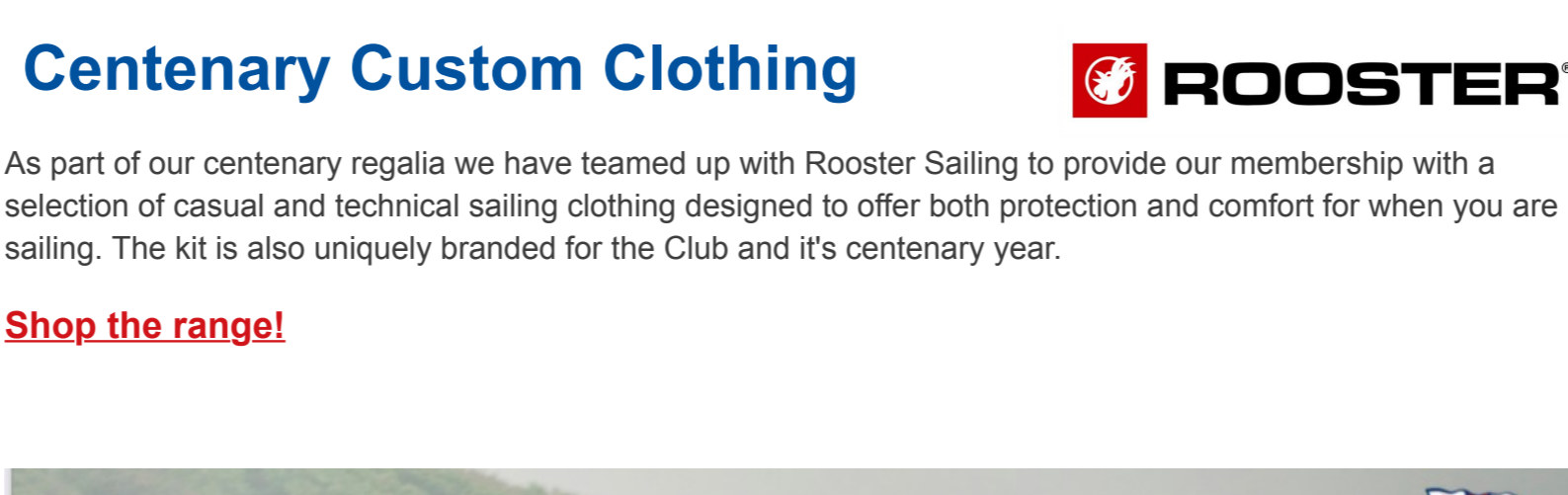


Centenary Custom Clothing

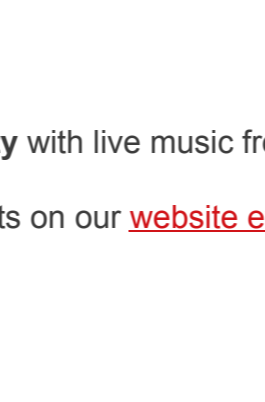

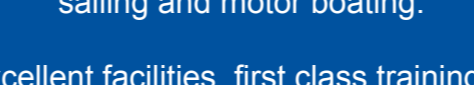
