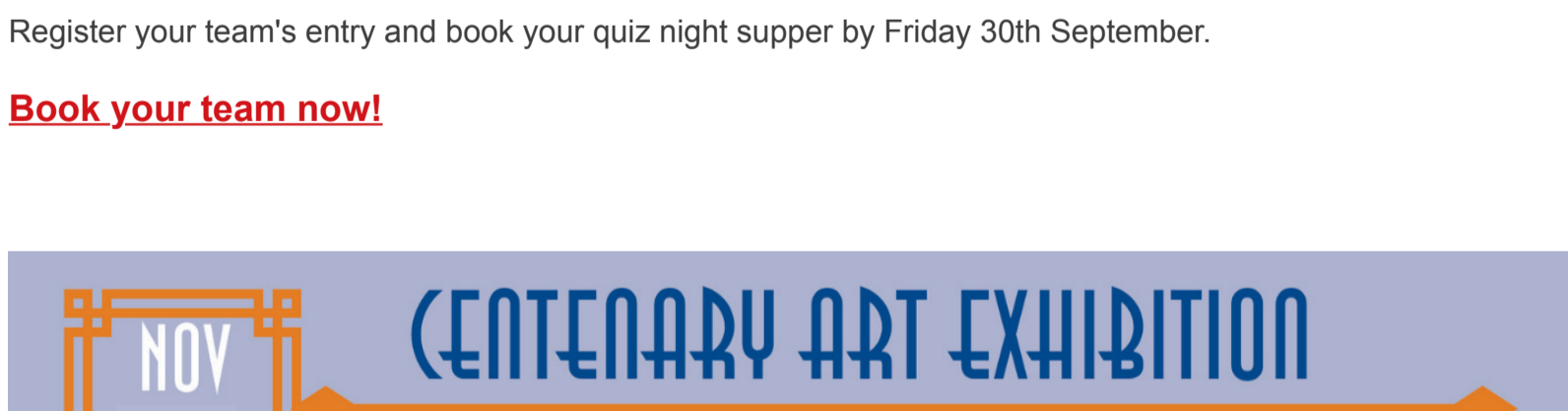
## Quiz time with Vince at RLymYC!

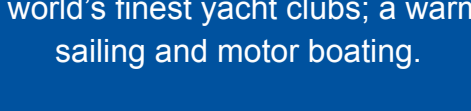
