The Club was a hive of activity at the weekend! Many thanks to all the volunteers who gave up their time to be at our Open Day and Crew Match, both of were a great success.

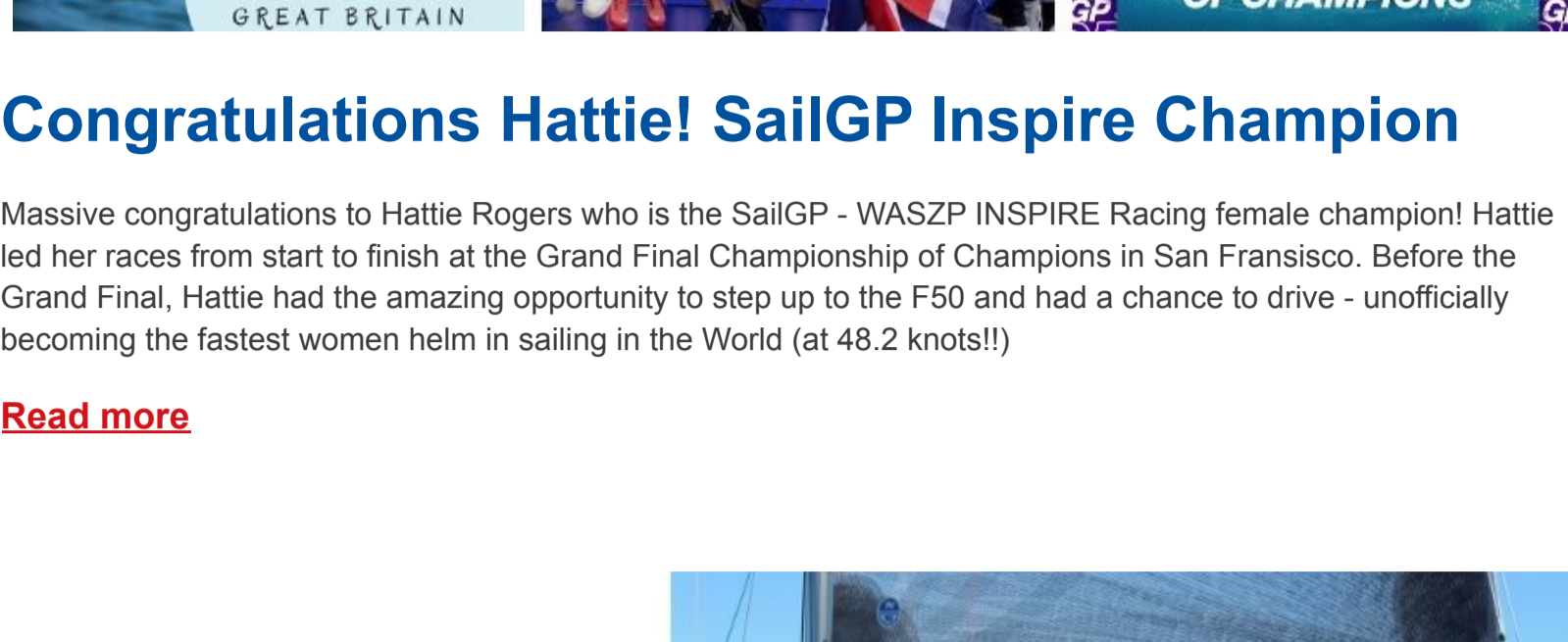

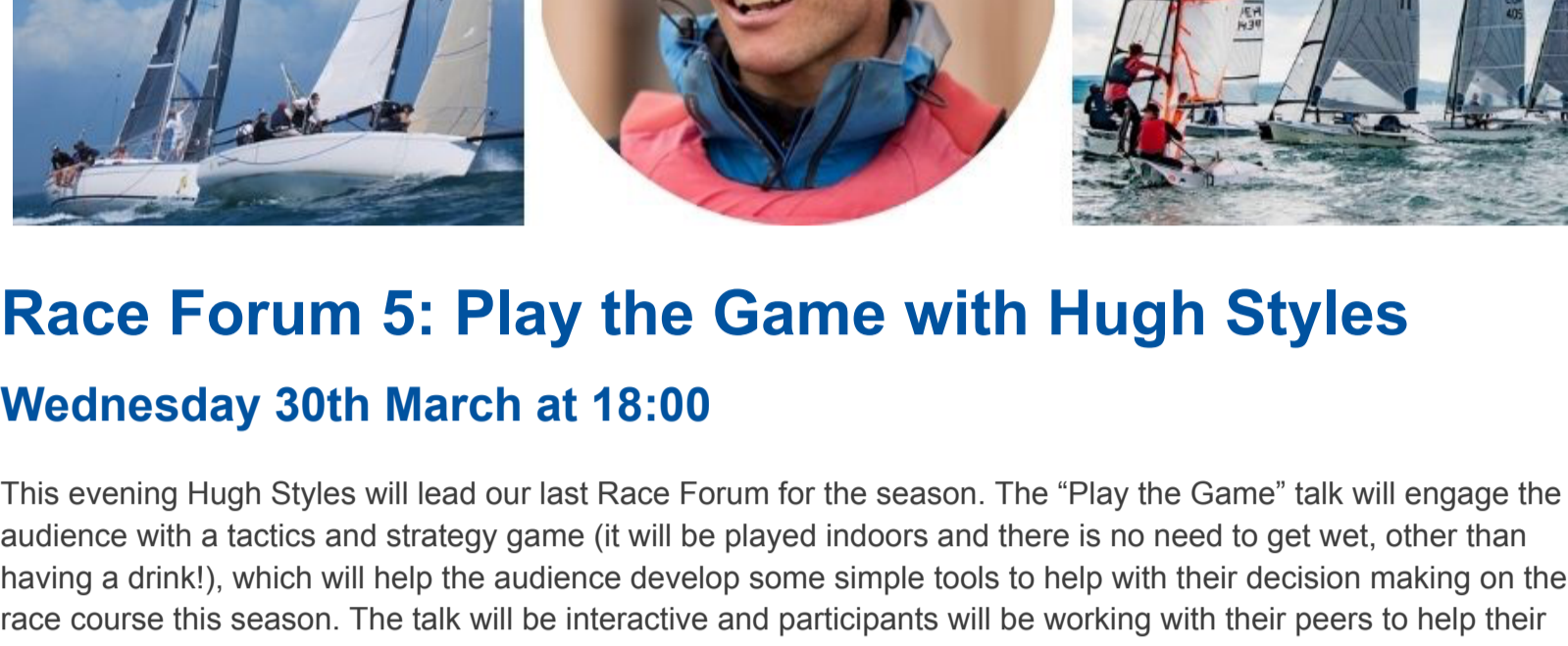
### Our 2022 Spring Series starts this Sunday 3rd April

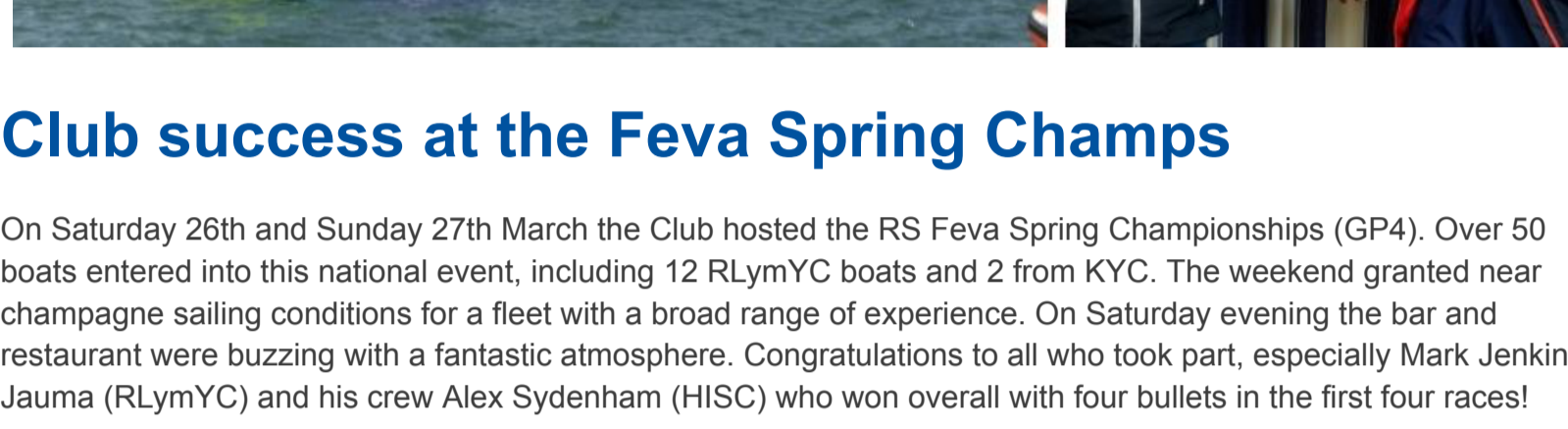


### Race Forum 5: Play the Game with Hugh Styles

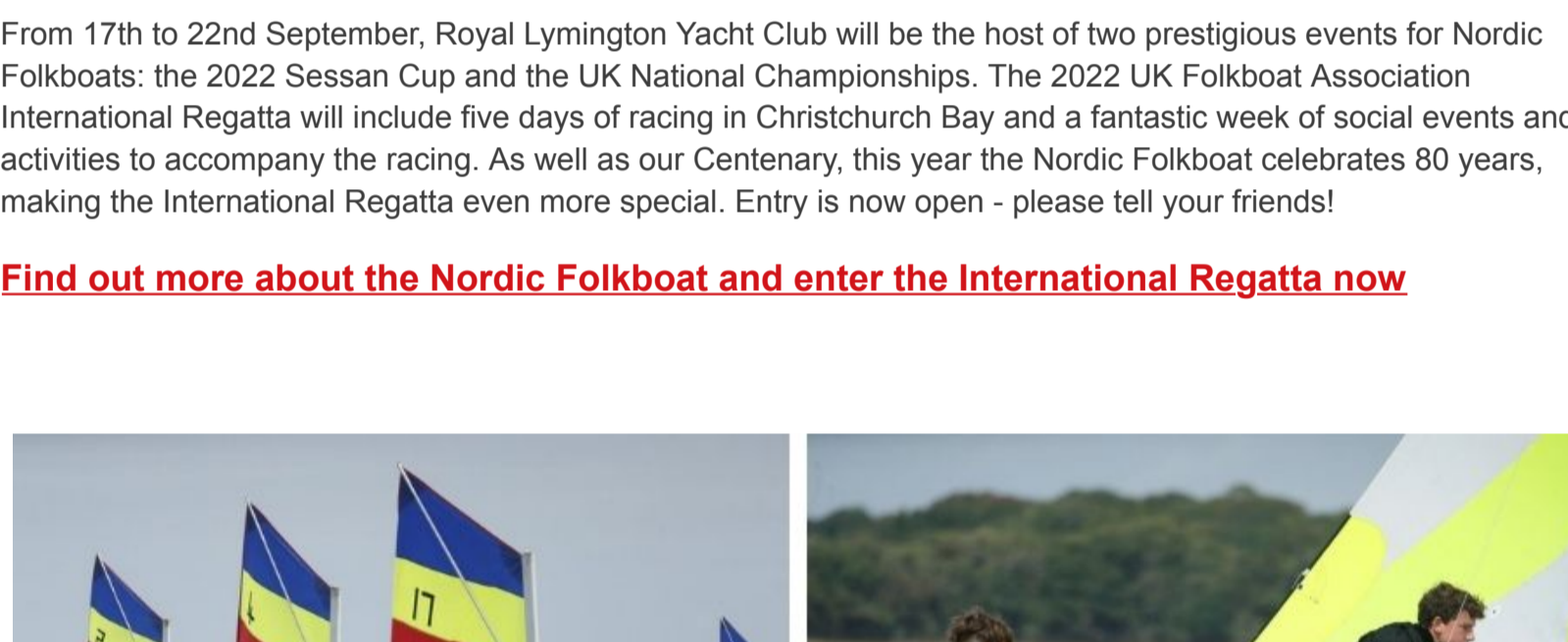


### Thanks to volunteers at Open Day and Crew Match

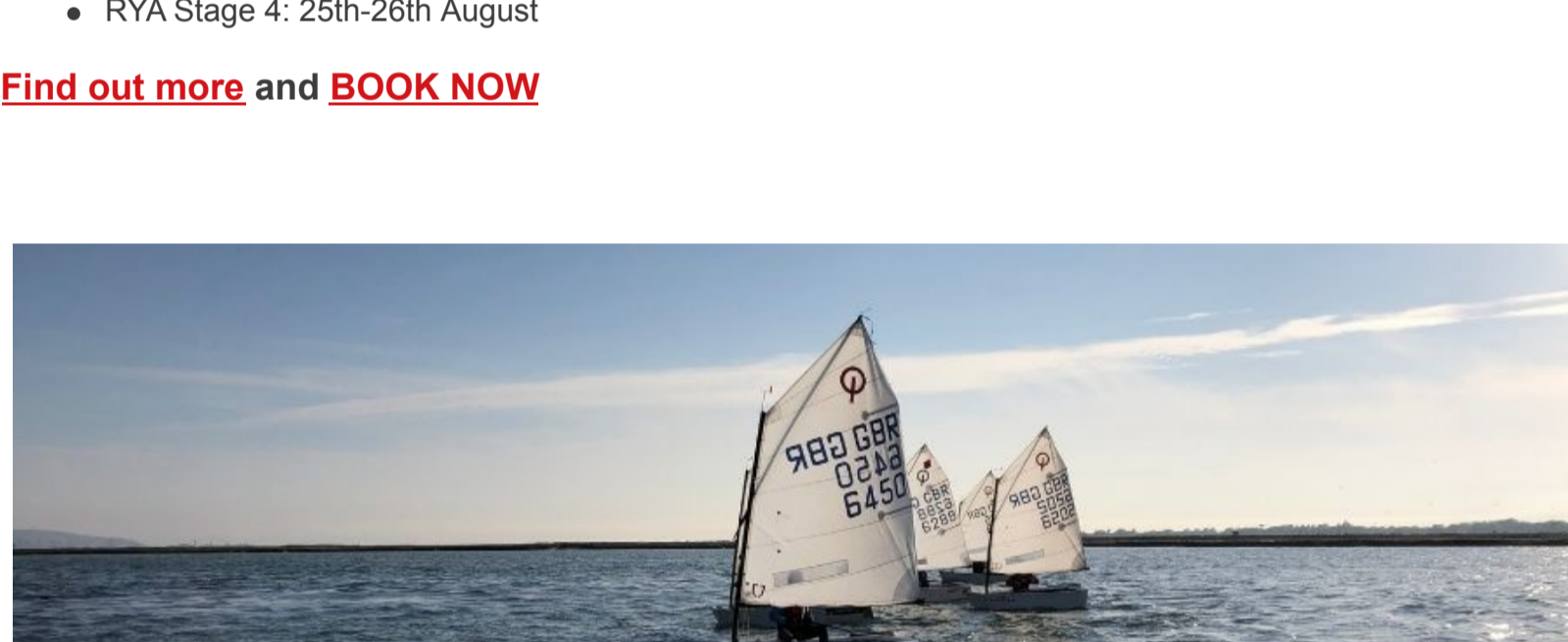

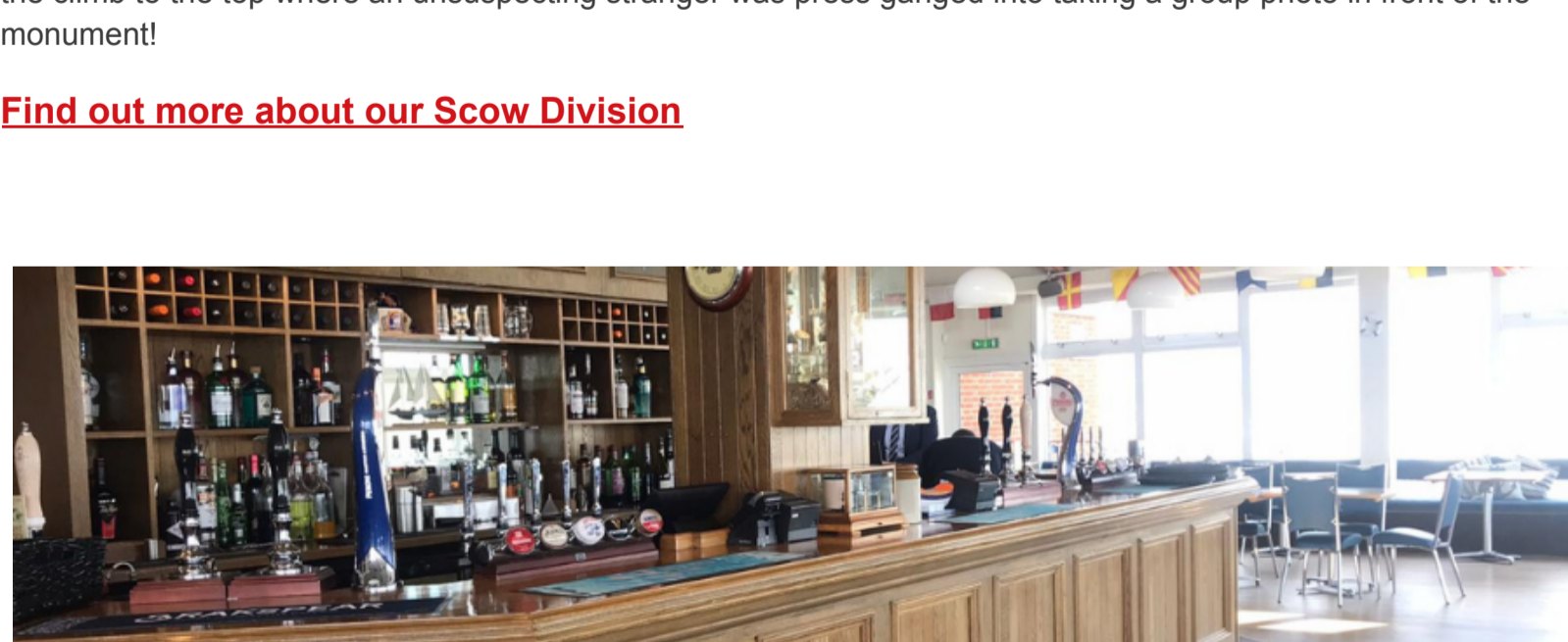

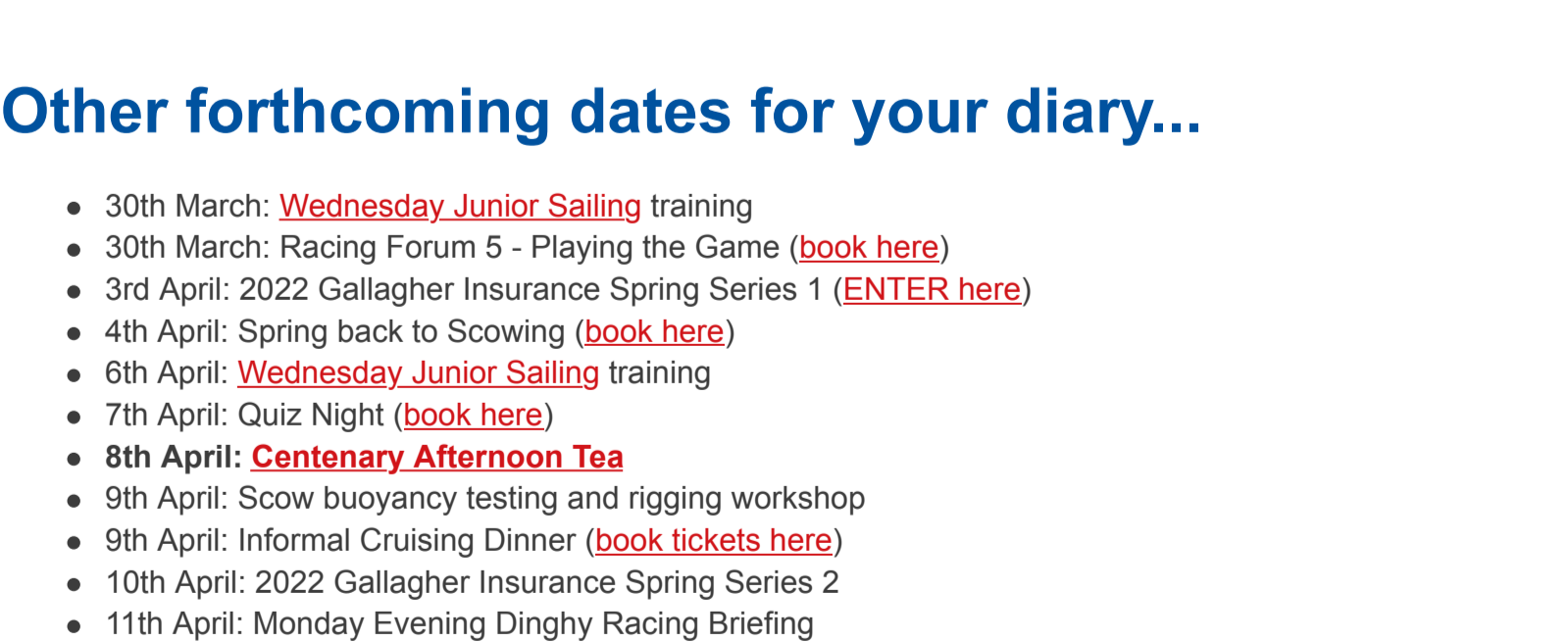
