Club Dinghy Park

Thank you to all the berth holders who have moved their dinghies this winter to allow us the space to resurface the main club dinghy park; we are very grateful for your cooperation. The resurfacing has now been completed and the surface is very even and it is now possible to push a dinghy trolley easily across the surface. All that remains to do is to mark out the area with posts and lane chain.

The annual R Lym YC 2023 berth discs, trolley tags and Lynton Harbour Launching discs along with confirmation of your allocated space are due to be sent out this week. Please can you ensure that the R Lym YC berth discs are displayed visibly on the mast (or trolley for dinghies stored with mast down). Any dinghy in the Balance Pond or Dinghy Park that does not have a current R Lym YC berth disc cannot be identified as a club member, so will be removed or locked up.

There is now a Dinghy Park Information Leaflet available as hard copy in R Lym YC reception or on the club website [Dinghy Park](#). This explains how the dinghy park is managed by the club including reference to displaying the annual R Lym YC berth discs, Sailing Activity Log (SAL) and the Dinghy Park berth sublet system.

Any club member who would like to berth a dinghy in the Dinghy Park will find that there are usually vacant berths that can always be accessed for fixed periods of time by using the Dinghy Park berth sublet system.

Cruising Lecture Season

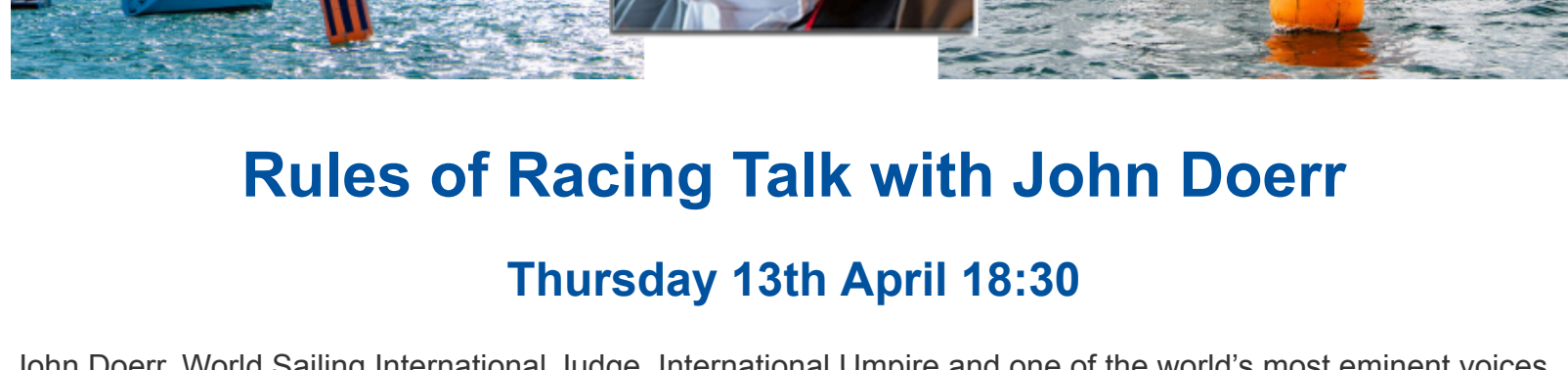
2023/2024

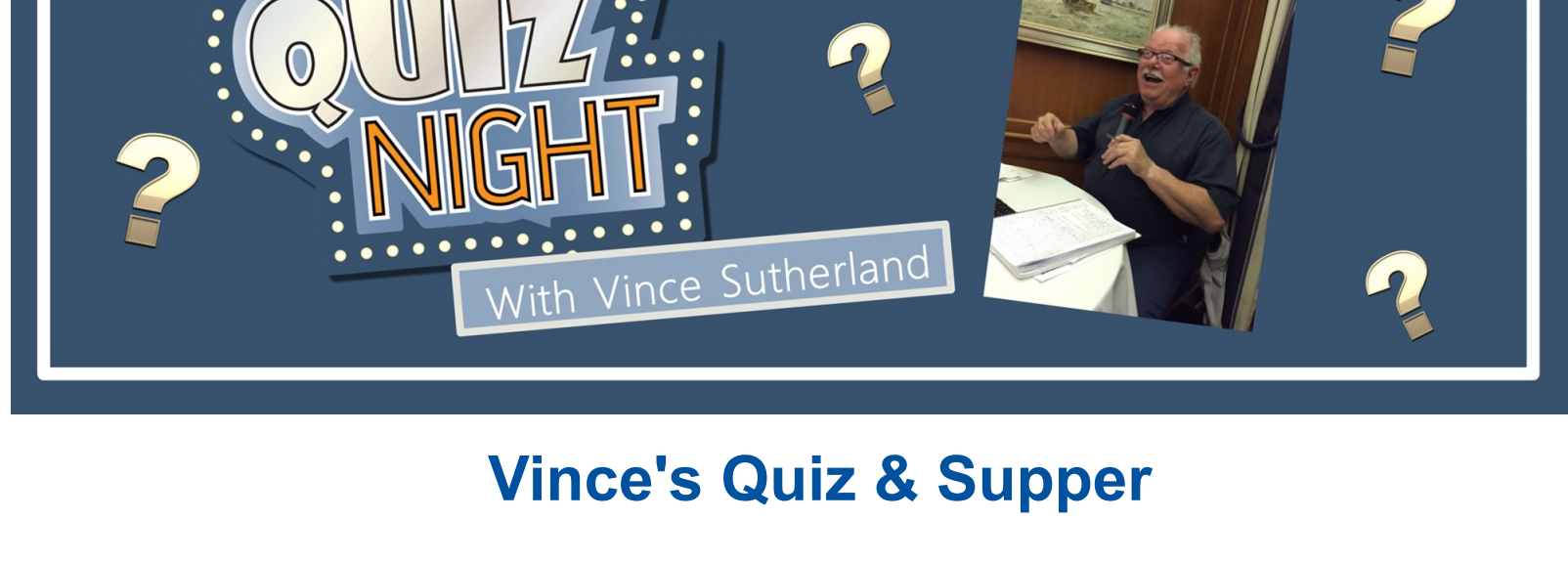

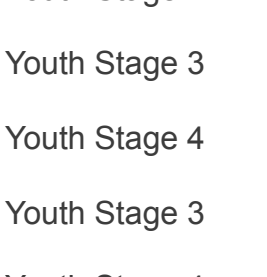
