- Simplify shopping - save you time and money

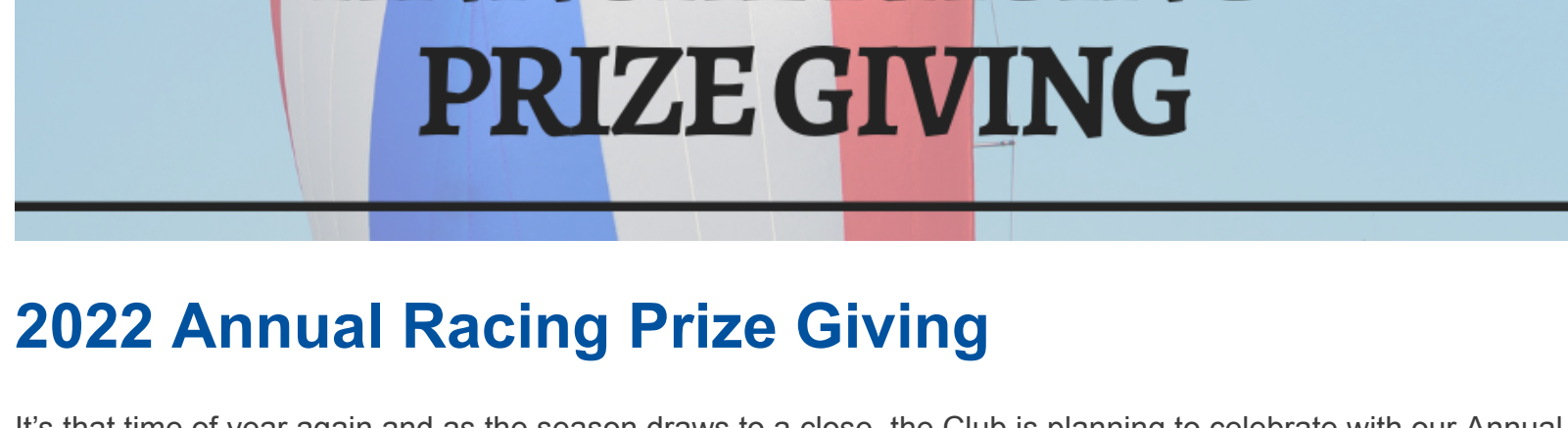

### Winter Lecture Season at RlymYC

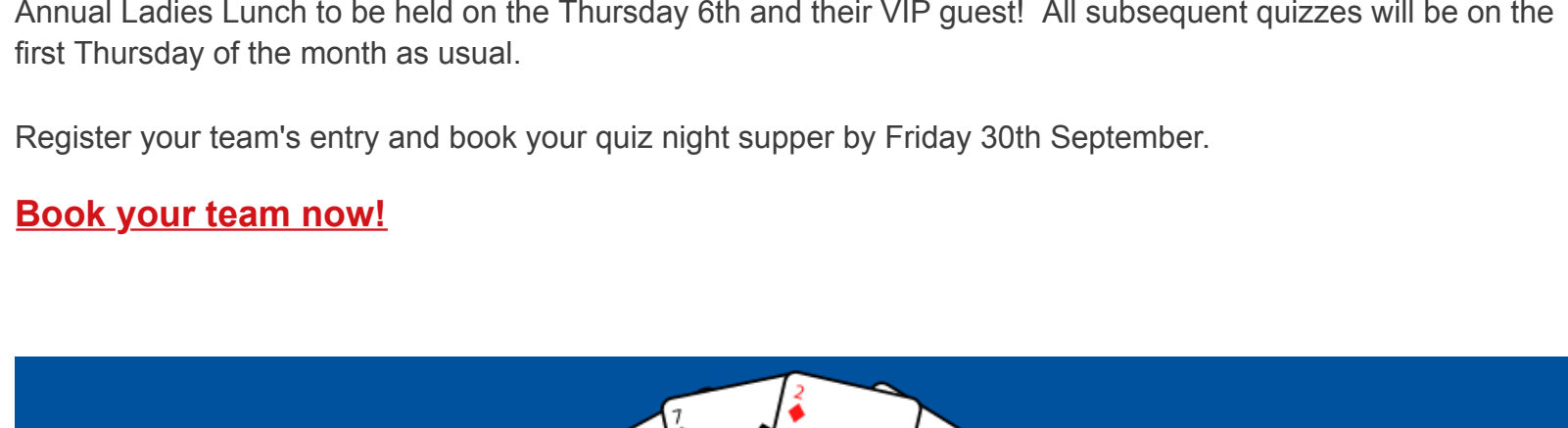

After a long hiatus our bridge suppers are back in the calendar! As before the pandemic, they are back on the 2nd and 4th Monday of each month from October to March.

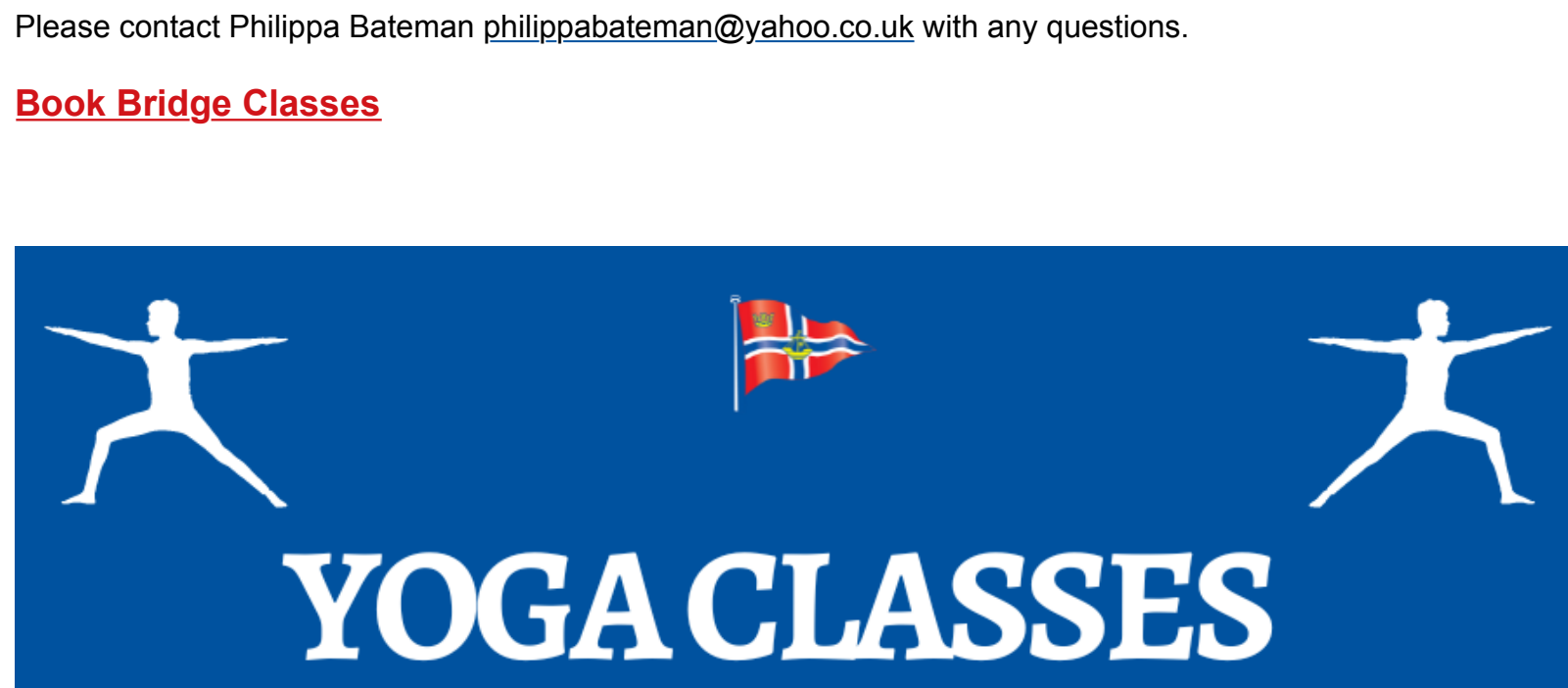

### Art Exhibition - Judged by Simon Chadwick

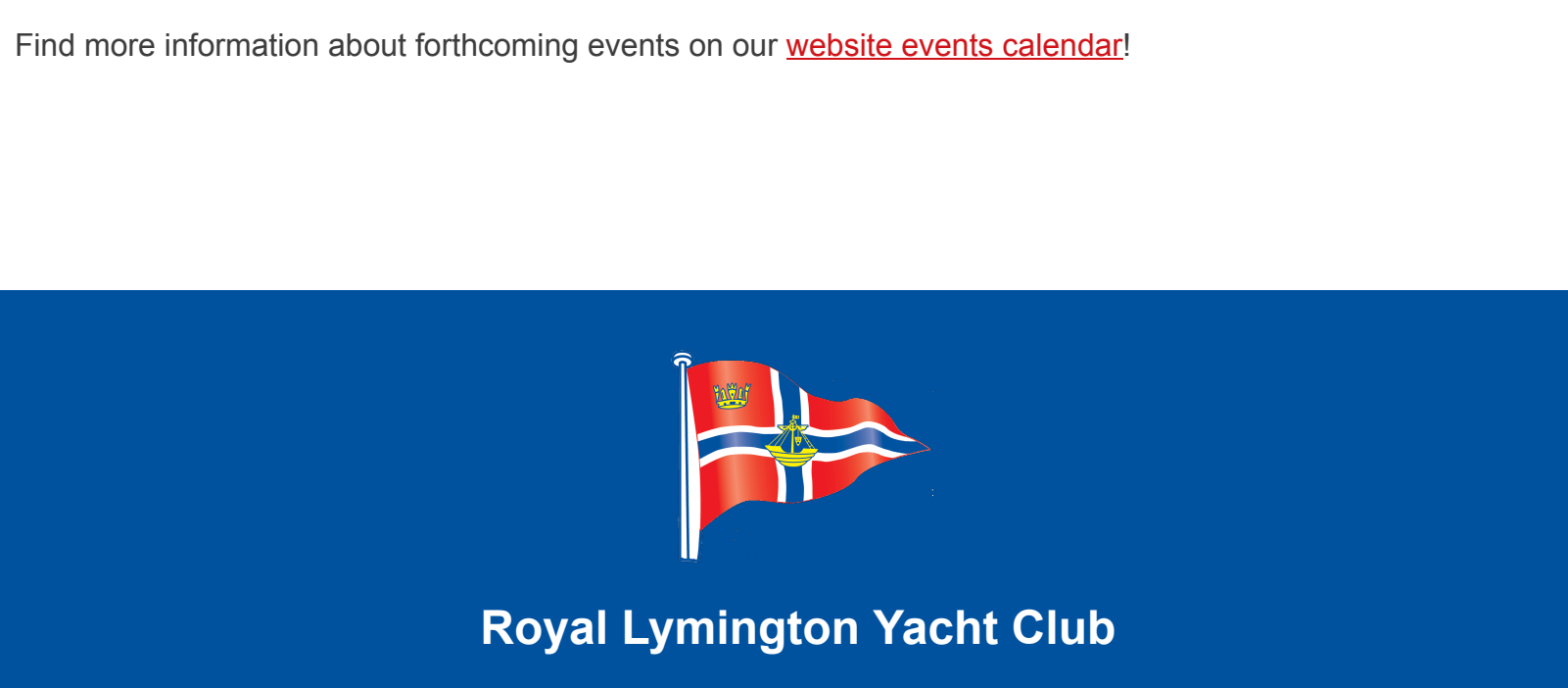
Exhibits welcome from Junior Members
