THURSDAY 7TH OCTOBER

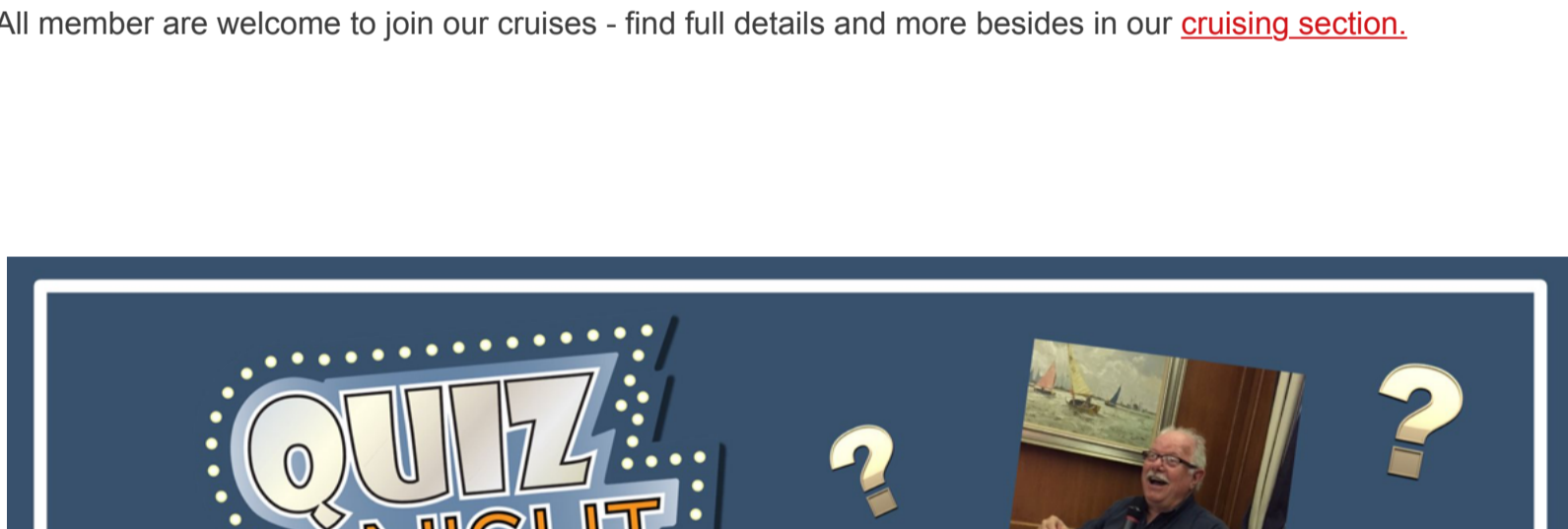
Cruise to the Beaulieu River with lunch at RSYC Gins Club House, HW (springs) at Bucklers Hard is predicted for midday.

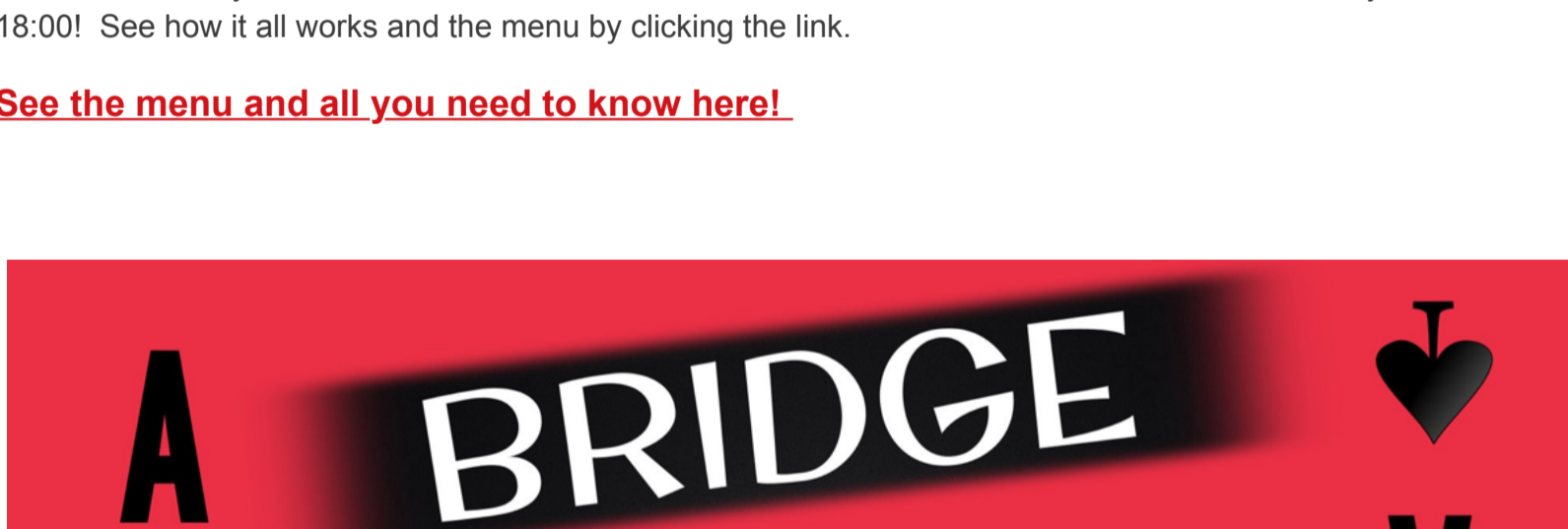

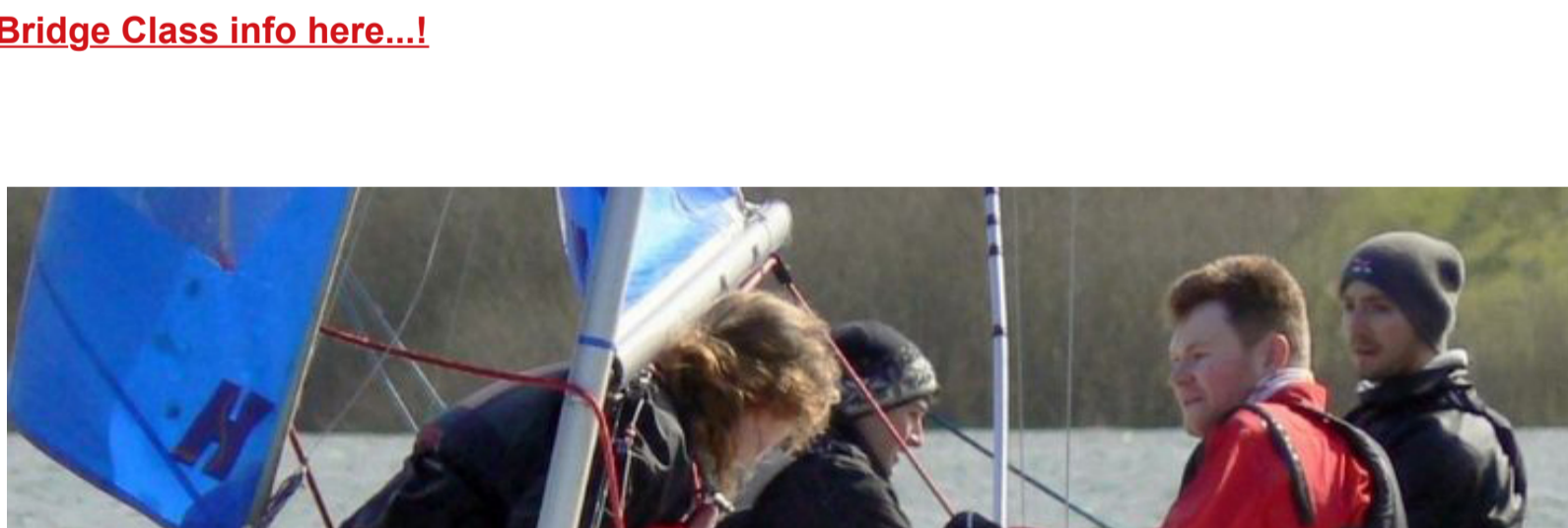

Team Racing - open to all competent dinghy sailors

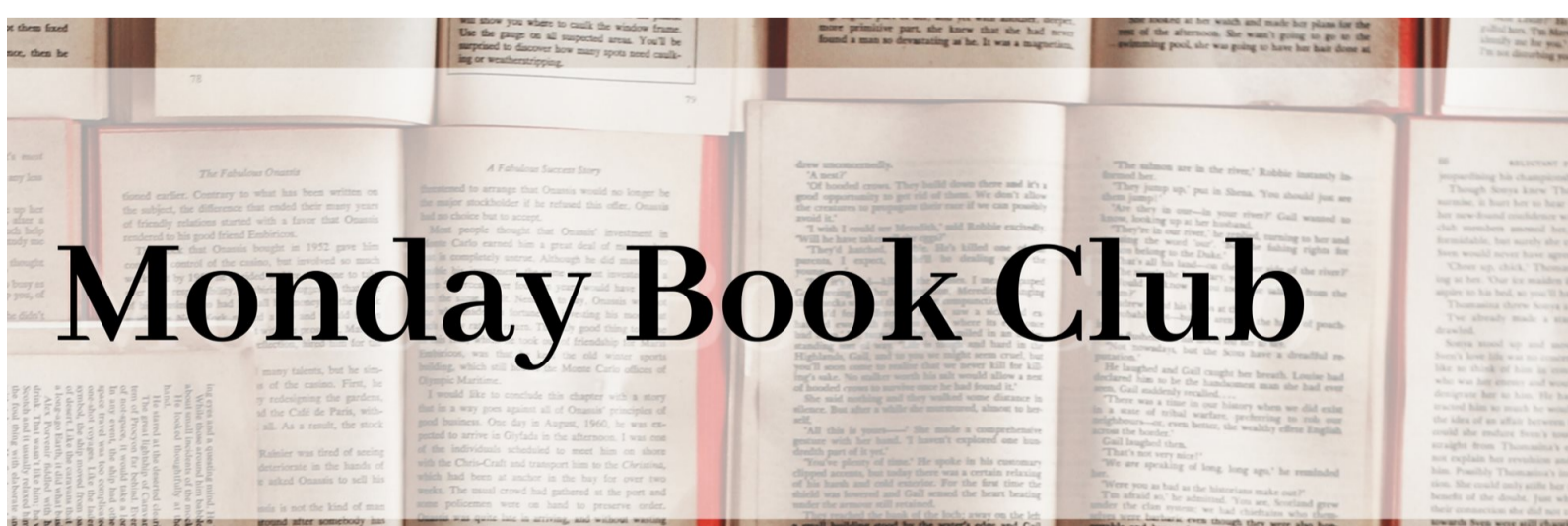

RealBridge Online with Marilyn Holmes



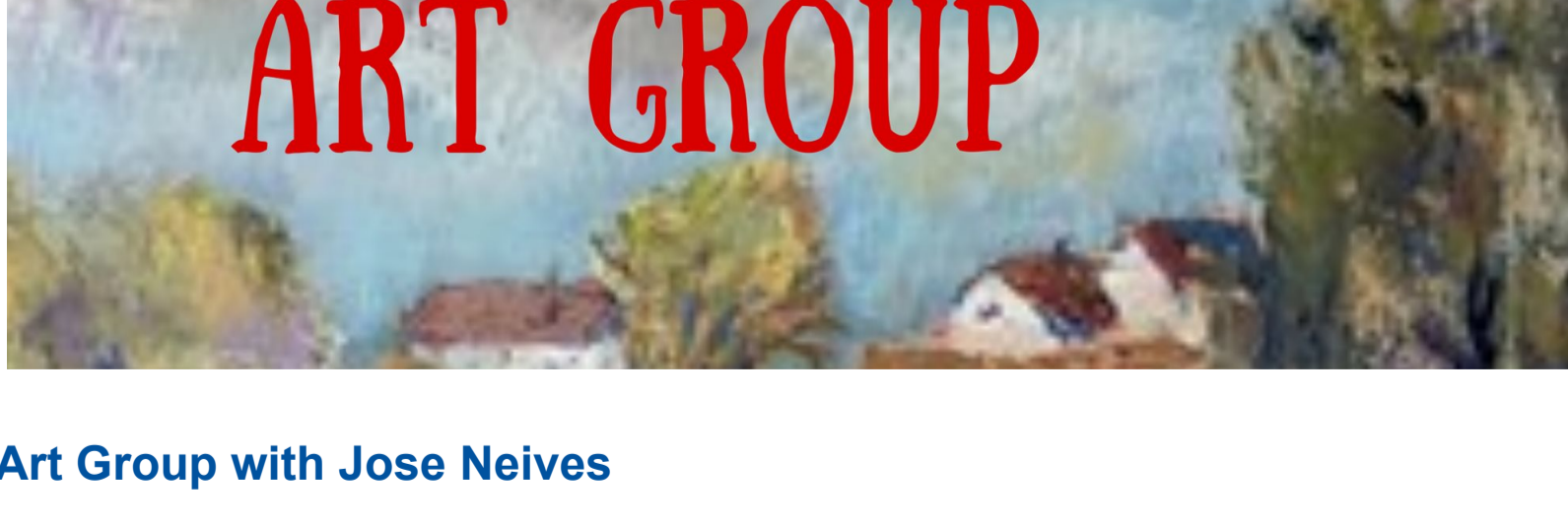

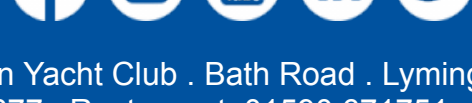
